Step One: Attend the Presentation

- Learn how to legally give someone authority to make medical and financial decisions for you in case you are unable to do so in the future.
- Learn about expressing your desires regarding health care wishes, including life support, before the need arises.

Step Two: Income Qualifying Individuals May Stay For the 2pm Workshop

Volunteer attorneys will help income qualifying individuals complete various advance planning documents.

- You must be financially eligible for free legal services to receive help at this part of the clinic. You will be asked to complete a form to check your financial eligibility, so come early.
- Applicants will be seen on a first come, first serve basis.
