Statement on COVID-19:

Over the course of the weekend, we learned that an attorney who appeared in multiple courtrooms last week was diagnosed with COVID-19. That attorney is in quarantine with mild symptoms. Court staff and parties who may have been exposed have been notified and given guidance on the appropriate steps to take.

After consulting with the Denver Department of Public Health and Environment, Denver District Attorney Beth McCann and Deputy Public Defender Demetria Trujillo, I have decided in the interest of public safety that the Lindsey-Flanigan Courthouse will be closed Monday, March 23 and Tuesday, March 24, 2020, to allow the courthouse to be thoroughly sanitized.

I have also decided that all district court criminal dockets will be suspended for the week of March 23. During this time, the Court will work with defense counsel and the district attorney to implement virtual courtrooms where all appearances will be conducted via remote access once criminal dockets resume.
