When a Child Support Services (CSS) case is started:

- Parent applies for TANF (Temporary Aid to Needy Families) benefits
- Parent applies for CCAP (Child Care Assistance Program) benefits
- Parent applies for CSS and pays \$20 fee (fee may be waived upon approval)

Services CSS provides:

- Location of parents
- Establishment of paternity orders (genetic testing if appropriate)
- Establishment of child support orders
- Enforcement of child support orders
- Modification (changing) child support orders
- Tracking of payments (Family Support Registry)

What happens when CSS becomes part of a court case:

- CSS attorney will attend hearings addressing the issues mentioned above
- The CSS attorney does not represent either parent

Remedies available to CSS:

- Income assignments (similar to garnishments)
- Driver's license suspensions
- Passport holds
- Tax refund offsets
- Credit Reporting

Services offered to either parent through the Parenthood Program:

- Employment assistance
- Housing and food assistance
- Parenting Classes
- Legal assistance
- Addiction assistance
