<b>PRESIDENT TRUMP'S RESPONSE TO COURT'S ORDER</b>	

Respondent President Donald J. Trump (“President Trump”) responds to Question Two of this Court’s *Order Re Court requests after reviewing pleadings filed on September 29, 2023*. Specifically, President Trump notifies this Court of his position that Petitioners’ actions do not moot President Trump’s Anti-SLAPP motion. His reasoning will be set forth in his *Reply*.

President Trump respectfully suggests the following procedure to streamline this procedure and ensure continuity. Although Petitioners have abandoned Count II, this Court has not yet entered an order dismissing Count II.
