| <p>COLORADO REPUBLICAN STATE CENTRAL COMMITTEE’S NOTICE OF SUPPLEMENTAL AUTHORITY</p> | |

Intervenor, Colorado Republican State Central Committee, by and through undersigned counsel, hereby submits Notice of Supplemental Authority, as follows:

1. On November 8, 2023, in *Grove v. Simon*, No A23-1354 (MN November 8, 2023), the Minnesota Supreme Court issued an order rejecting efforts to keep former President Trump off the ballot in that state. The Order ruled that plaintiffs lacked standing to disqualify President Trump from the November 5, 2024, general election as a candidate for the President of the United States

and rejected on the merits an attempt to exclude him from the ballot for the March 5, 2024, presidential primary. The Order is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

2. In *Grove*, the Minnesota Supreme Court Held:

Thus, although the Secretary of State and other election officials administer the mechanics of the election, this is an internal party election to serve internal party purposes, and winning the presidential nomination primary does not place the person on the general election ballot as a candidate for President of the United States. As we explained in *De La Fuente*, in upholding the constitutionality of this statutory scheme for the presidential nomination primary, ***“[t]he road for any candidate’s access to the ballot for Minnesota’s presidential nomination primary runs only through the participating political parties, who alone determine which candidates will be on the party’s ballot.”*** 940 N.W.2d at 494–95. ***And there is no state statute that prohibits a major political party from placing on the presidential nomination primary ballot, or sending delegates to the national convention supporting, a candidate who is ineligible to hold office.*** [Emphasis added]

3. The Colorado Republican State Central Committee requests that the Court consider this authority in its pending findings of fact and conclusions of law.
