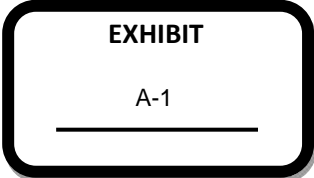

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1 MICHELLE MALKIN: Hey, everyone. Happy Friday.
 2 It is the Friday edition of #MalkinLive, and as I have
 3 been doing since the day after election day, I'm bringing
 4 you information that is so vital to understanding the
 5 systemic stealing of our election, and this particular
 6 angle, the Dominion Voting Systems angle, many of you have
 7 been seeing a lot of information out there. It has made
 8 its way up to President Trump, Rudy Giuliani. I think
 9 there was one segment on Fox News about this.
 10 But there is a specific avenue of this story that
 11 I'm going to delve into with an entrepreneur,
 12 philanthropist and political activist Joe Oltmann, who's
 13 right here in my adopted home state of Colorado, and
 14 Colorado is one of the places that Dominion actually has a
 15 corporate headquarters office, and let me bring him in
 16 right now.
 17 Hey, Joe.
 18 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Hey, how you doing?
 19 Thanks for having me, Michelle.
 20 MICHELLE MALKIN: Wow, you are on Twitter, even
 21 though you're not on Twitter right now.
 22 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah, yeah.
 23 MICHELLE MALKIN: We're live streaming on
 24 Periscope and YouTube and Facebook, and so far I've
 25 experienced a limited amount of throttling as I've brought

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1 stories from independent citizen journalists and GOP poll
 2 watchers who have eyewitness accounts of the fraud that's
 3 going on.
 4 You were zapped last night by Twitter, and so I
 5 wanted to let you use this platform to explain what you've
 6 discovered about Dominion, and one figure, very key figure
 7 in particular, and then get your thoughts on the
 8 deplatforming and censorship that's going on on people who
 9 are telling the truth.
 10 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah. So it's really actually a
 11 scary thing, because when I started this process of
 12 looking into voter fraud, I never started it, right?
 13 It's like I set out and said, hey, listen, I
 14 really want to find out what's going on with Dominion.
 15 Dominion wasn't even on my radar.
 16 If you go back in time, I was -- you know, I
 17 started an organization called FEC United, that stands for
 18 faith, education and commerce, and this just came out of
 19 what we're seeing happen not only in Colorado but across
 20 the country, where they strip away Constitutional rights.
 21 Now prior to that, I remained relatively silent
 22 or at least with my name personally in the space of just,
 23 you know, pursuing and making sure that we have
 24 constitutional integrity in this country, but they started
 25 attacking me.

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1 So these journalists started attacking me, they
 2 started attacking John "Tig" Tiegen, who obviously is --
 3 he's an American hero --
 4 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 5 JOSEPH OLTMANN: -- and basically slandering him
 6 everywhere, and so I wanted to know why. Like why would
 7 journalists actually come after someone as significant as
 8 Tig, in this environment?
 9 So I set out to uncover Antifa within the
 10 journalist community. So that's how it actually started
 11 and that's where this journey started.
 12 So if you go back in time to the week of the 27th
 13 of September or thereabouts, right --
 14 MICHELLE MALKIN: Mm-hmm.
 15 JOSEPH OLTMANN: -- I was out, just infiltrating
 16 Antifa, I'll just tell you, I just used -- I run a tech
 17 company, obviously I'm right of center, I'm a
 18 constitutional and conservative Christian. I wanted to
 19 know what we were really dealing with.
 20 So I got on this call, and in this call you hear
 21 all this fascist, fascist, fascist, fascist, all this
 22 stuff that's kind of going on and going back and forth.
 23 It's like a swirling of rhetoric.
 24 It's unbelievable how they speak to each other,
 25 by the way, okay? It's -- you know, I don't think that

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1 they even understand how much they sound like Chicken
 2 Little, and so I listened for awhile and then somebody
 3 named Eric came on and started -- started talking, and so
 4 he's talking about what they need to do next, they need to
 5 make sure that you hold on to, you know, fortify and that
 6 we need to -- you know, add constant pressure, and so on
 7 and so forth.
 8 And so as he starts to talk, someone says, who's
 9 Eric? And then someone answers, Eric is the Dominion guy.
 10 So obviously I'm taking notes, right? And I'm a
 11 copious note taker. So I took these notes and I had Eric,
 12 Dominion, and then we're in Denver, Colorado, because
 13 they're talking about Denver, they're talking about
 14 Colorado Springs. But I wasn't really focused on him.
 15 So then Eric responds, you know, keeps speaking
 16 and then someone interrupts and says, what are we going to
 17 do if F'ing Trump wins? And he responds with, and I'm
 18 going to paraphrase this because obviously I didn't write
 19 exactly what he wrote, right? Is, don't worry about the
 20 election. Trump is not going to win, I made F'ing sure of
 21 that, ha-ha-ha, right? And then somebody responded, F'ing
 22 right, right? So sorry, I'm not going to cuss on your
 23 podcast.
 24 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah, that's okay.
 25 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Just not going to do it.

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1 So Eric continues with the fortifying of the
 2 groups and recruiting and, you know, he's very eccentric
 3 and boisterous. A lot of hubris, right?
 4 They just don't understand that, you know, that
 5 there's not a lot of security in what they talk -- for me
 6 to get involved in that conversation and get on that
 7 conference is telling, right?
 8 So then I went away and I did my research and I
 9 was able to uncover 13 Antifa journalists, not just
 10 through that call but through other things, and so I did
 11 the research on Eric. And so it was really simple, this
 12 is what I did, right? I put in "Eric" into a Google
 13 search, "Eric, Dominion, Denver, Colorado." Not very
 14 clever, right? That's how it all started.
 15 And it came up with this gentleman named Eric
 16 Coomer. So Eric Coomer is the director of strategy and
 17 security at Dominion Voting Systems.
 18 And so I did a little research more on him, got
 19 his backstory, he has a PhD in nuclear physics and seems
 20 like a really, really smart guy. Has a vast history in
 21 coding.
 22 I did some research on, you know, some of the
 23 patents that he holds and election stuff, but it didn't
 24 make sense to me that that would be him, right?
 25 So I set it aside and said, oh, this guy must

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1 work for, you know, CIA, FBI someone else. Someone's got
 2 to know who this guy is, right?
 3 And so the further I got into this, this kind of
 4 circle, this kind of mulling, the less I was inclined to
 5 think that he was very important. I didn't know Dominion
 6 was in multiple states. I didn't follow the whole
 7 election system, right? Shame on me, and shame on the
 8 rest of America for not paying attention to this too.
 9 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 10 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So then I got on a -- it was
 11 October 15th. I spoke at the FEC United meeting at
 12 Bandimere Speedway. We had a recording that Eric Trump
 13 did for FEC -- actually for Tammy Bandimere already, he
 14 mentioned FEC United. It was a great night, we had a lot
 15 of people there.
 16 But at that meeting, I called out the journalists
 17 that work for Antifa and I said very clearly, we're coming
 18 for you. If you want to write bad things about us because
 19 you're Antifa, we're coming for you. I'm going to make
 20 sure everyone knows who you are, right? And by the way, I
 21 run a data company, so good luck to you, right?
 22 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 23 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So from there they started --
 24 again, the same, you know, characters started then
 25 creating this hysteria that, oh, Joe's going to attack

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1 journalists, right? So then I got calls from journalists
 2 everywhere and I go, that's not what I said. I can send
 3 it to you, but that's not what I said.
 4 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 5 JOSEPH OLTMANN: And typical Antifa style, they
 6 create more rhetoric, right? More lies about people and
 7 frankly, I've been undeterred, right?
 8 So fast forward --
 9 MICHELLE MALKIN: You know, it is a very
 10 deliberate gaslighting campaign.
 11 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Hundred percent.
 12 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 13 JOSEPH OLTMANN: And frankly, it is a conspiracy.
 14 It's not a conspiracy theory, it's a conspiracy,
 15 when people come together and actually do things to harm
 16 our country, right?
 17 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 18 JOSEPH OLTMANN: And 2020, you couldn't have
 19 written this in a hundred years, but Orwell did back with
 20 1984, right? He wrote this, he told us what was going to
 21 happen and it's happening, right?
 22 So but as -- fast forward to Friday, right, after
 23 the election I went to bed thinking, all right, Trump's
 24 got this, he's winning, right? I went to an election
 25 party. Everything looked good, statistically speaking.

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1 It didn't align with what I thought he would win
 2 by, so I thought it would be 331 electoral votes that he
 3 would win by. I did actually predict a landslide because
 4 I have access to data all over the country, right?
 5 Now I predicted that he'd win in 2016. I did.
 6 And I was right. I showed up at the GOP event in Colorado
 7 and I was like high-fiving people and they're like, oh,
 8 we're going to have Hillary Clinton and I was like, no,
 9 we're not. We are not going to have Hillary Clinton.
 10 And so, you know, I remember this ingrained in my
 11 head, but on Friday I get a text message and a call from a
 12 friend of mine and he sends me this thing on this article
 13 in Georgia that talked about the electronic glitches and
 14 the fact that they did an update in the middle of the
 15 election day.
 16 And so I -- normally I don't read the articles,
 17 I'm just going to tell you, I get three to 400 emails a
 18 day and I don't have time. I don't have time to go
 19 through every email or every text message. It pisses
 20 people off but frankly, I'm just really busy. I have lots
 21 of things going on, as you do, right?
 22 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah, a little. Yeah.
 23 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So he sends it to me, I started
 24 reading it and Eric Coomer's name pops up inside of the
 25 deal, and I was like, Eric Coomer, what? Are you serious?

I'm sorry if people that listen to you don't hunt. 4 I do hunt. I'm known in my community as being someone that 24 gives generously, in almost every environment. Nobody 25 could ever say, oh, Joe is -- he's only doing this</p>

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1 because, you know, he wants notoriety. I don't need
 2 notoriety and I don't need money.
 3 I don't need either one of those things, right?
 4 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 5 JOSEPH OLTMANN: And I didn't ask for it.
 6 I'm very happy just silently going through my
 7 life helping people and being that person that lives a
 8 legacy for my family, right?
 9 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes. So in other words, this
 10 story found you, not the other way around.
 11 So we've brought up this screen cap from Eric
 12 Coomer's Facebook page. Explain what this is.
 13 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So actually if you go 20 and
 14 then we can show 21. So this is actually a video and if
 15 you go watch the video, it -- it's -- it's the innuendo --
 16 it's what he's actually saying by putting this video up.
 17 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 18 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So if you go to screen capture
 19 2021, you'll be able to see that he has another one
 20 that -- I'm going to try and follow you at the same time.
 21 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah, hold on. Let me see if I
 22 can do it this way. 21. Here we go.
 23 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah. So F the USA.
 24 So this is a guy that's responsible for the
 25 strategy and security of election machines across the

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1 country -- and by the way, in the last four years, they
 2 have signed up all these swing states, right?
 3 And those election devices, while you are voting,
 4 are hooked up to the internet.
 5 Look, Michelle, this is not -- I am not making
 6 any of this up. This capture that you have is his
 7 Facebook page. And by the way, if he's not guilty, why is
 8 he scrubbing the internet? Why did he take down
 9 everything from Dominion showing up on his -- even like
 10 lead candy that shows up who's actually executives and
 11 environments, taking that down.
 12 Going even one step deeper, removing all of his
 13 Reddit handles, removing all of his Twitter handles -- and
 14 some of them are disgusting. Removing all of the stuff
 15 out there that he has, that he's been out there doing this
 16 with a massive amount of hubris, right?
 17 And we haven't even gotten to the juicy ones yet,
 18 but I mean you go to 22, the same thing, right?
 19 MICHELLE MALKIN: And so by the way, the
 20 whitewashing happened not long after you started tweeting
 21 about it.
 22 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Right.
 23 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 24 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Right. Oh, no, he definitely
 25 knows that -- he definitely was listening to my podcast --

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1 he has listened to my podcast -- again, remember I run a
 2 data company, right? So if you don't think that I can
 3 actually gather and get to information where I can see
 4 what people are doing -- I can, right?
 5 And people would say, okay, well, Joe, Joe's a
 6 white guy. Well, let me just tell you a little bit about
 7 white guy Joe. So my dad's black, my mom's white, my
 8 whole family is interracial, and if you want to think that
 9 I can't understand the plight of accountability with the
 10 police, my brother was murdered by a police officer three
 11 years ago, right?
 12 MICHELLE MALKIN: I'm sorry to hear that.
 13 JOSEPH OLTMANN: I still back the blue, right?
 14 I have -- everything's individual. Like we talk
 15 about journalists. There are some good journalists, we
 16 just can't see to find them in the sea of bad journalists,
 17 right? I mean, that's the problem we face today.
 18 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 19 JOSEPH OLTMANN: But -- and so I have my
 20 sensibilities to me. I have the fact that, you know,
 21 they've tried, these journalists have tried to call me a
 22 racist, they've called me many things and it can't stick
 23 because I'm like, well, that... that doesn't work. How
 24 did that work out for you?
 25 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah, and it doesn't phase you.

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1 JOSEPH OLTMANN: No.
 2 MICHELLE MALKIN: So here's the Eric Coomer post.
 3 It's, you know, classic anticop vitriol, this is NWA. I
 4 lived through the '90s in Los Angeles, so I know.
 5 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah. So if you go to the
 6 number 25, right, you will actually see him comment on
 7 that one.
 8 MICHELLE MALKIN: Okay.
 9 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Right? And you'll get a feel
 10 for kind of the things that are -- that he -- how he feels
 11 about it, right?
 12 MICHELLE MALKIN: Right.
 13 It's just seething and over the top.
 14 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah. So he did this. Right?
 15 And so I'm F'ing over it and then somebody says,
 16 that was obvious when you brought in Ice-T. Jokes aside,
 17 I totally agree. And then he says Cop Killer's a great
 18 song, regardless of the way Ice-T has turned out, right?
 19 MICHELLE MALKIN: Right, right.
 20 JOSEPH OLTMANN: I mean, this is a guy that is
 21 not nonpartisan. This man is not nonpartisan. This guy
 22 is on -- he is on a mission to make sure that the only
 23 opinion that anyone hears or that anyone can actually
 24 accept is his own. And you would say, Joe, come on,
 25 that's not true. Well, actually, it is.

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1 So if we go down to -- and I'll put this -- I'll
 2 let you put this up here.
 3 MICHELLE MALKIN: Mm-hmm.
 4 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Let me see if I can find it.
 5 That's not it. And I sent you the file. So just so
 6 everyone listening, Michelle has 80 of these.
 7 MICHELLE MALKIN: 80 of these, yes.
 8 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Right? And.
 9 MICHELLE MALKIN: By the way, you just showed so
 10 much foresight in capturing these, because they would have
 11 otherwise gone down the rest of the rabbit hole --
 12 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah.
 13 MICHELLE MALKIN: -- with all of the other
 14 whitewashed information about this guy.
 15 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Right. And there's no way he
 16 can escape this. He can't.
 17 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 18 Which is why you're being silenced, Joe.
 19 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Right.
 20 MICHELLE MALKIN: Because you got the goods.
 21 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So if you go to number 72.
 22 Now, this goes all the way back to 2016. So the
 23 reason why I'm going to this is because this shows that
 24 his rage towards people that disagree with him grew,
 25 right? So this is what extremism, this is what happens in

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1 extremism. Now, I spent many years in the Middle East and
 2 in Africa, right? Working in conflict areas, and so I
 3 understand how extremism starts to just -- it starts to
 4 fester, right? You start to create your own reality, and
 5 that's really what's happened in our country.
 6 MICHELLE MALKIN: Mm-hmm.
 7 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So this is a rant, he says rant,
 8 Facebook friend land open call. If you're planning to
 9 vote for this autocratic, narcissistic, fascist, asshat,
 10 blowhard and his Christian jihadist VP pick, unfriend me
 11 now. No, I'm not joking, I'm not for reason, political
 12 discourse and healthy debate, no. I'm all for reasonable
 13 discourse and healthy debate. I'm looking at you, and he
 14 names people. I disagree with you three on so many
 15 philosophical grounds, but respect your opinions. Only an
 16 absolute F'ing idiot could vote for that windbag F-tard
 17 fascist racist F. No BS. I don't give a damn if you're a
 18 friend, family or random acquaintance, pull the lever,
 19 mark an oval, touch the screen for a carnival barker.
 20 Unfriend me now. I have no desire whatsoever to even
 21 interact with you. You are beyond hope, beyond reason,
 22 you are controlled by fear, reaction and BS. Get your S
 23 together. Oh, and if that doesn't persuade you, F you.
 24 Seriously, this F'ing ass clown stands against everything
 25 that makes this country awesome. You want in on that?

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1 You deserve nothing but contempt, and he goes on and on
 2 and on, right?
 3 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 4 JOSEPH OLTMANN: This is 2016.
 5 2020, fast forward on it, the guy is literally
 6 talking about killing the president, F the USA.
 7 That's what he evolved into, right?
 8 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes, right.
 9 JOSEPH OLTMANN: And there's plenty of more in
 10 this deal that would just blow your mind, on the comments
 11 that he said. Go ahead, sorry.
 12 MICHELLE MALKIN: And again, just to repeat for
 13 people, if you're just tuning in. This is Eric Coomer.
 14 He is a top official and Joe you've mentioned now, he is a
 15 shareholder --
 16 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yes.
 17 MICHELLE MALKIN: -- in Dominion Voting Systems.
 18 This is not some 19-year-old liberal undergrad at Harvard,
 19 this is a patent holding nuclear physicist who was leading
 20 conference calls -- planning calls, essentially.
 21 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah.
 22 MICHELLE MALKIN: And, you know, stoking calls,
 23 right? I guess, you know, cheerleading calls for Antifa
 24 types, and you infiltrated these calls before election
 25 day. We're talking about --

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1 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah.
 2 MICHELLE MALKIN: -- late September when these
 3 were happening, and you got to hear the unhinged rantings
 4 of this lunatic in charge of security at Dominion Voting
 5 Systems.
 6 JOSEPH OLTMANN: And it gets worse.
 7 MICHELLE MALKIN: It gets worse.
 8 JOSEPH OLTMANN: And I'm going to -- if you go to
 9 capture number 56.
 10 MICHELLE MALKIN: Okay.
 11 JOSEPH OLTMANN: This is -- and by the way, this
 12 is not -- in my opinion, this just shows the darkness, and
 13 I actually did analyze this picture all the way down to
 14 what he has on the shelves and everything else but I'm not
 15 going to go into that because that will freak you out and
 16 then people will be like, ah, it's got to be a conspiracy.
 17 Nope, it's not, but I want you to see this picture.
 18 MICHELLE MALKIN: Ah. What is this?
 19 JOSEPH OLTMANN: That's Eric Coomer.
 20 MICHELLE MALKIN: Ah, are you kidding me?
 21 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah. So his mind is... you
 22 know, I've seen people get to the point where everything
 23 is negative, and negative eats at your soul, right?
 24 I've seen it happen, right?
 25 And I was able to research everything from

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1 ex-girlfriends that he has to his parents -- I mean, I did
 2 a lot of research. I don't want to bring any family into
 3 it because he's responsible for his own behavior, but I'll
 4 tell you, it's just a dark -- there's just a darkness that
 5 exists in what he writes, there's a darkness that exists
 6 in how he behaves. It's an unhinged -- it's unhinged. I
 7 mean, I don't know how to -- I don't know how to put it
 8 any other way than -- or I'm sure you have people in
 9 Texas, right? So we can probably go to that one. He
 10 loves people in Texas. I mean, he talks about people in
 11 Texas as if they're pieces of garbage.
 12 MICHELLE MALKIN: What number is that?
 13 JOSEPH OLTMANN: That is... let me see if I can
 14 find it.
 15 MICHELLE MALKIN: We do have lots of Texas
 16 viewers right now. If you're from Texas, give me a shout
 17 out.
 18 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah.
 19 MICHELLE MALKIN: Just type "T" in Comments,
 20 Facebook, YouTube, Twitter listeners, you're going to love
 21 this.
 22 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Number 38. Number 38.
 23 MICHELLE MALKIN: All right.
 24 JOSEPH OLTMANN: And this is crazy. This is how
 25 he sees people. This is how he sees people.

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1 MICHELLE MALKIN: You said 38?
 2 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yes, ma'am.
 3 MICHELLE MALKIN: All righty, get this one up.
 4 Okay, here we go.
 5 JOSEPH OLTMANN: I can read it. This is in 2017,
 6 right? So he's down there selling voting systems, by the
 7 way, I just want you to know. So I got access to RFP's, I
 8 got access to court documents. I have access to the --
 9 what he did in Arizona in 2019 to implement those voting
 10 systems in Maricopa County, the one that we're having a
 11 problem with.
 12 MICHELLE MALKIN: Go figure.
 13 JOSEPH OLTMANN: That's the one you're having a
 14 problem with. That's the one that has leaned Trump
 15 dramatically during the election.
 16 I want to be clear. I support President Trump,
 17 but I support free and fair elections more than I support
 18 President Trump. So if Biden would have won legally,
 19 right? I would have taken my sandwich, right, and walked
 20 home and said, look, we've got to do a better job of
 21 having a vision for America that people want to buy into.
 22 But when you have so many things that are wrong
 23 and the American voice is suppressed, you have nothing but
 24 -- that you can do, other than stand up.
 25 MICHELLE MALKIN: Mm-hmm.

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1 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So at this particular one -- do
 2 you want to read it or do you want me to read it?
 3 MICHELLE MALKIN: You go ahead.
 4 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So this one says, ah, Texas, the
 5 land of racists, idiots and misogynists. In two hours
 6 I've heard what's wrong with having a relationship with
 7 another powerful country? Russia in parentheses. I love
 8 Trump. Damn women's just done no her to listen -- how to
 9 listen. You know, darlin?
 10 And this is in a language that you really can't
 11 -- you're pretty, wish we didn't have to tip them. Them
 12 robots is coming, and then hash tag, F you.
 13 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 14 JOSEPH OLTMANN: This is how he sees everyone but
 15 himself and people that agree with him, right?
 16 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 17 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Now, I have a friend that's a
 18 psychologist, I sent it to him first and I said, hey,
 19 listen, do me a favor. I want you to review these, and he
 20 came back and he says, that is sociopathic. That is
 21 someone that literally does not have a firm grip on
 22 reality. So this is the guy that is the director of
 23 strategy and security. I'm not a psychologist, so I do
 24 ask other people for advice, right? And I've only asked
 25 one, so maybe I need to ask 50 because then I have a

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1 proper analysis on whether or not it's accurate, but you
 2 can't have someone that's thinking this that is
 3 responsible for our elections.
 4 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 5 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Right?
 6 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 7 JOSEPH OLTMANN: And if you go to number 37.
 8 This is from 2017. He's in Nevada, by the way.
 9 MICHELLE MALKIN: Okay.
 10 JOSEPH OLTMANN: You'll notice that this one is,
 11 hey from Nevada. He's actually sitting in Nevada. What
 12 happened in Nevada, Michelle? Do you remember what
 13 happened in Nevada, what we're dealing with right now?
 14 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 15 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Do you know what election
 16 machines can't pass the Benford law study? Nevada.
 17 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 18 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Arizona.
 19 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 20 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Wisconsin.
 21 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 22 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Michigan, Pennsylvania, Georgia.
 23 MICHELLE MALKIN: All Dominion states.
 24 JOSEPH OLTMANN: All Dominion states.
 25 MICHELLE MALKIN: But as you say, he -- this Eric

<p style="text-align: right;">Page 26</p> <p>1 Coomer had patents related to other voting software 2 systems. 3 JOSEPH OLTMANN: That are used in other voting 4 systems -- 5 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes. 6 JOSEPH OLTMANN: -- at other counties. 7 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes. 8 JOSEPH OLTMANN: We're only -- we're focused in 9 on Dominion. This is a deep deal.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">Page 29</p> <p>1 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Come to my house and I'll show 2 you the inciter of violence, I'm going to tell you right 3 now. You do something to affect someone around me, right? 4 I will not ask questions. Don't come to my house looking 5 for a conversation because I don't want one, right? 6 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah. 7 JOSEPH OLTMANN: If you want to have a 8 conversation, send me an email or call me and tell me how 9 you're going to hang me from a tree. That went really 10 well. That was a really good conversation. 11 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah, yeah. 12 By the way, for those who are just joining or if 13 you joined in late, all of this stemmed from Joe trying to 14 understand the journalists who are essentially Antifa 15 operatives, and there have been a couple of other really 16 brave people who have infiltrated, like you did, other 17 rings and rackets between Antifa and the media. 18 There was a researcher, an independent 19 researcher, Ian Lenahan, who published his own work -- 20 because he had infiltrated many of these circles -- in a 21 magazine called Quillette, a website called Quillette, and 22 he was zapped off of social media, death threats against 23 him as well, and you really are over the target -- I keep 24 saying this -- 25 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah.</p>

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1 MICHELLE MALKIN: -- about all of the people I've
 2 interviewed over the last week -- you know you're over the
 3 target, and this one is such a sore spot. I mean, it is
 4 the key, the collaboration between the Fourth Estate and
 5 the violent mob.

6 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah. And it's frankly, you
 7 know, people are submitting, right? I had a conversation
 8 with someone, Michelle, at a event where I was asked to
 9 speak to a hundred people -- and I got to tell you
 10 something else about me, I'm actually not an extrovert,
 11 I'm an introvert. I'm a guy that literally likes to -- I
 12 don't particularly like putting myself out there.

13 I just felt the responsibility and I felt that
 14 God was telling me to -- I gave you these gifts, you have
 15 to use them, right?

16 But I was at this meeting and this woman goes,
 17 this is just a pacifier. We need to give them a pacifier.
 18 We -- if we give them this election, then they'll calm
 19 down, they'll calm down, and I go, you have no idea what
 20 you're saying. You don't know what you're saying. You
 21 don't actually know what you're asking for. They're never
 22 going to -- they're never going to retreat. If you give
 23 them this, it's going to be more. We're going to be a
 24 socialist society, you're going to give up your free and
 25 fair elections forever.

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1 And beyond that, it's going to get even worse
 2 because you're not going to have opportunity. Your kids
 3 aren't going to have opportunity, your grandkids aren't
 4 going to have opportunity. You're going to become an ant
 5 on the ant farm that generates revenue for them, right?
 6 They get to decide whether or not you're successful. They
 7 get to decide what opportunity you have -- and I grew up
 8 poor. So you're not talking to someone that doesn't
 9 understand opportunity. I had to claw my way to the place
 10 where I am today, right? And so everything I had, I've
 11 been blessed with by God, but I had to work for it.

12 I had to work for it.

13 So do you want to be the one that only gets these
 14 oligarchies that actually have opportunity, these
 15 billionaires -- which, by the way, increased \$845 billion
 16 while all these small businesses were collapsed, right?

17 This is -- you have to make a decision. You have
 18 to make a decision right now what you want. There is no
 19 retreat, there is no surrender.

20 President Trump is fighting for us, we have to
 21 fight for him. And I don't care if it was someone else
 22 that was in that chair, right? If they're fighting for
 23 us, we have an obligation to fight for him. We have an
 24 obligation to uncover these things.

25 This is the legacy of your life. This is the

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1 test that I think God put you through is that can you
 2 stand up when things are against you? Can you stand up
 3 when people frankly are doing the -- doing bad things? I
 4 think it's our obligation to do that. It shows the
 5 courage. Courage is more infectious than fear.

6 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes, and you've got the exact
 7 proper framework on this. It is a fight between good and
 8 evil, not just between right and left and if we don't
 9 fight it now... I mean, I hate to be a pessimist about
 10 this, but all the factors that led to this manufactured
 11 crisis have been coming to a boil for 30, 40, 50 years,
 12 whether -- I mean, it's everything that you concentrate on
 13 with FEC United -- and by the way, I want to recommend
 14 that people go to FEC United. The "F" stands for faith,
 15 the "E" stands for education, the "C" stands for commerce.

16 These are the things that we pursue in our lives
 17 to achieve the American dream. It's what my own parents
 18 did when they sacrificed everything to come here from a
 19 foreign land, and I've been mentioning of course that they
 20 escaped a Banana Republic to make their home in a
 21 constitutional republic, and if we don't have free and
 22 fair elections, that's it. Game over.

23 And that's why you're risking everything to get
 24 this information out there.

25 JOSEPH OLTMANN: So I do want to say this because

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1 I think it's going to be important: So I started
 2 Conservative Daily 11 years ago. I've used the alias or
 3 moniker Joe Otto as -- underneath that.

4 And in Conservative Daily, 780,000 members, we're
 5 in -- you know, we now have a podcast obviously that has
 6 become pretty popular over the last six months.

7 But under Joe Otto, I am Joe Otto. So Joe
 8 Oltmann, I'm the real life person of Joe Otto. It's taken
 9 me 11 years to come out, but I did because I think I was
 10 forced to. I was forced to say, look, I finally have to
 11 put a face and name to all the effort that we've put up
 12 there -- and by the way, at Conservative Daily we fought
 13 against republicans too. We fight against RINOs and
 14 people that have worked against the better interest of
 15 people.

16 So I don't believe in what's popular, I believe
 17 in what's right. So what's right is rarely popular,
 18 what's popular is rarely right and sometimes you have to
 19 fight against the grain in order to create success for our
 20 society. I don't think that there's a lot of people out
 21 there that have the courage that you have and that
 22 President Trump has, but that becomes infectious if more
 23 people stand up and go forward.

24 MICHELLE MALKIN: So -- absolutely. So let's
 25 talk about the deplatforming. You were not told by

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1 Twitter why they unilaterally zapped your account. What
 2 time was it that this happened? Was it last night?
 3 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yes. So last night, around
 4 10:00 o'clock at night, I'm actually on Twitter and I'm --
 5 I was retweeting Rogan O'Handley's tweets, I'm like a big
 6 fan of his so I always like his stuff and, you know, when
 7 all this stuff came out -- so I was retweeting that and
 8 then all of a sudden someone was attacking Tig, and so I
 9 responded to them saying, how would you like this domestic
 10 terrorist or something, this right wing extremist coming
 11 to a classroom -- because he went into a classroom on
 12 Veterans Day to talk to kids about the sacrifice the
 13 veterans make.
 14 So I responded to that. As soon as I responded
 15 to that, boom, my whole page came down and it said, you
 16 know, you have been suspended, and I'm like, what? What
 17 did I say? Because I make sure -- because they've done
 18 this twice before. Like I called out Antifa, they
 19 suspended me for a week, just for calling them out.
 20 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah.
 21 JOSEPH OLTMANN: I didn't violate any laws there
 22 either, right? But if you go to the Colorado Springs
 23 Antifa page on Twitter, they have it -- their moniker at
 24 the top says doxing, right? You know, people get doxing.
 25 You're not allowed to do that, per their own deal, but

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1 they do it and they let it stay up there.
 2 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 3 JOSEPH OLTMANN: What does that tell you about
 4 Twitter? What does that tell you about their leadership?
 5 What does that tell you about their organization?
 6 Twitter is Antifa.
 7 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yes.
 8 JOSEPH OLTMANN: You can say whatever you want,
 9 but they are Antifa.
 10 So yeah, I can't get to my messages, I can't get
 11 to notifications. I did file an appeal. I did talk to my
 12 attorneys this morning. And the bad thing about me is
 13 that I will burn cash at an alarming rate to hold people
 14 responsible, right? And I've got an army of 90,000 or so
 15 people in Colorado that are part of FEC -- we did that in
 16 25 weeks, by the way -- 90,000 people that will also get
 17 behind me and help us fund something that goes after
 18 Twitter.
 19 So we're going to go after Twitter if they don't
 20 turn it -- you know, reverse it. And who knows if they
 21 will, right? They think -- they have the same hubris that
 22 Eric Coomer has: I'm untouchable, right?
 23 But are you? But are you?
 24 MICHELLE MALKIN: Yeah, that's right.
 25 In the meantime, you are on Parler, continuing to

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1 share information.
 2 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah.
 3 MICHELLE MALKIN: And I had also shared one of
 4 your tweets.
 5 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah.
 6 MICHELLE MALKIN: And I -- it has 1700 retweets
 7 and 2500 likes and people are still trying to find it and
 8 find out what happened, but they can find you on Parler
 9 now, and I just want to bring up that screen as well, at
 10 Joe Oltmann, J-O-E O-L-T-M-A-N-N.
 11 We have about ten minutes left and I wanted to
 12 give you an opportunity to talk about the work that you've
 13 been doing on the ground in Colorado with FEC United
 14 because it is such a fresh breath -- breath of fresh air.
 15 It's the kind of organizing that I've been
 16 involved in for -- as long as I've been out of the closet
 17 as a conservative activist and journalist, but it's also
 18 the kind of on the ground activism that so much of the GOP
 19 establishment has spurned.
 20 Is that your experience as well?
 21 JOSEPH OLTMANN: Yeah, yes. So I think the
 22 problem with conservatives, people that are
 23 constitutionally centered, is that we eat our own. That
 24 our -- our ambitions become greater than the ambitions of
 25 others, right?

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1 And I think that the problem with that, that the
 2 danger of that is that we can't ever get along long enough
 3 to actually make progress.
 4 And so the left is a very weak and ineffectual
 5 voice, but collectively they become an effectual voice.
 6 They've infiltrated our education, they've
 7 infiltrated, you know, our -- technology and media. And
 8 when I say "infiltrated," they had a plan. They've been
 9 planning this for 25 years and what conservatives fail to
 10 do, is we fail to plan. We wake up every three-and-a-half
 11 years and we want to say, let's have a -- let's talk about
 12 this election. Ooh. So we wonder why we keep losing in
 13 certain key environments. We're not in technology. So
 14 I'm in technology and I'm a conservative but I'm one of
 15 the rare ones that speaks up in this environment.
 16 So FEC United was bent on the idea that we could
 17 create a law and policy center, that we could actually
 18 have teeth in what we do, that we could fatigue the left
 19 individually and collectively by pointing out things that
 20 they do that are unconstitutional.
 21 Now, faith is -- you saw through this pandemic in
 22 many states -- not states like North Dakota, which I
 23 applaud the governor, right? I think she's going to have
 24 an influx of conservatives that actually move there over
 25 the next couple of years -- and other parts of the

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1 country, they basically threw the Constitution in the
 2 trash and says, we know what's best for you.
 3 Well, when has the government ever done what's
 4 best for us, right? When did they grow a conscience? The
 5 Thursday before they decided to shut down our economy,
 6 while they gave big businesses access to -- basically what
 7 it came down to is like a free black Friday event every
 8 day, while they shut down small businesses because they
 9 said that is where COVID exists.
 10 But they also shut down our churches, they shut
 11 down our synagogues and our mosques. See, it's not just
 12 Christians that should enjoy religious freedom, it's all
 13 religions that should enjoy that, but they basically said
 14 that your spiritual food is not important. We need to set
 15 that aside.
 16 So the organization, on the faith side, is
 17 designed to give them power to stand together so they can
 18 tell, you know, Governor Polis here and other governors
 19 and other leaders that are unelected bureaucrats, that you
 20 cannot affect me, you cannot stop me from getting fed
 21 spiritually.
 22 On the education side, we have massive issues,
 23 Michelle -- massive -- and one of the biggest issues we
 24 have is we're going to have a pandemic, one of mental
 25 health and mass suicide of our young people if we don't

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1 get them back to school normally -- not the new normal,
 2 right? They don't get to change our society, right, and
 3 change our kids.
 4 And the other part of this is, is that kids are
 5 being indoctrinated. Second grade we have systems out
 6 there called Queer the Classroom, where they're recruiting
 7 kids to be gay in second grade. Now if you are gay,
 8 you're gay, right? We have gay, straight, black, white,
 9 green, yellow, purple people at my office.
 10 But you don't recruit a kid in second grade and
 11 try to change their mindset so that you can actually
 12 create more of an opportunity for you in the future.
 13 To me that's sick, right?
 14 You don't get to actually, as a teachers union,
 15 actually tell the parents or the kids and go against the
 16 teachings that the parents have tried to teach them,
 17 especially based on faith. You don't get to do that.
 18 So they have a union on the teachers side, we're
 19 going to have a parents union. We're going to have a
 20 union for parents, that allows for them again to take
 21 access to the law and policy center and actually go after
 22 them, not in one state but every state. So we started
 23 here. It will be a national organization.
 24 And the last two parts of the organization are on
 25 the commerce side, where were the Chambers of Commerce and


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1 the unions -- excuse me -- the associations when the
 2 pandemic lockdown happened for small to medium businesses?
 3 It wasn't there. It was absent.
 4 So you pay them to do nothing.
 5 So we're going to become a strong force in
 6 bringing those businesses together -- which we've already
 7 started doing, right? And we're going to make sure that
 8 we have the ability to stand together and we can stand
 9 against this fear tactic that they have for businesses,
 10 where they walk in and take away your license and say,
 11 hey, look, that piece of paper you have, the fact that you
 12 -- now you can't feed your kids, how about that? You have
 13 to do exactly what we say or we're going to shut you down.
 14 Well, they're shutting us down anyway, right?
 15 And they're handing back the keys of the kingdom
 16 to these big businesses.
 17 So then we have a policy and politics side that
 18 is not -- not defined in the FEC name, and that is
 19 electing people inside of our communities that actually
 20 stand for and come back to the community and frankly do
 21 the biddings of the people within the community, rather
 22 than what they do now, which is listen to lobbyists and
 23 special interest groups and do things to adversely affect
 24 our community or bark orders down to us as if we're slaves
 25 or indentured to them.

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1 So we also want to get people to run for office.
 2 People say, well, I don't have -- I don't have any
 3 experience. Well, if you haven't noticed, neither do
 4 they, right? So it's really important to understand that
 5 if you have a heart and you're authentic and you do things
 6 for the community, that that will all play out well when
 7 you run for office, at every level.
 8 And then obviously you know that our connection
 9 with UADF, United American Defense Force, that is the
 10 thing that John "Tig" Tiegen runs. It is a side-by-side
 11 organization with FEC United. It is its own organization.
 12 But these are people that are set there -- it's
 13 not a militia. They're set there to defend the community,
 14 in the community, to make sure that we can keep what we've
