JOE OLTMANN DISCUSSES HOW A SECURITY GENIUS AT DOMINION
VOTING PROMISED ANTIFA MEMBERS A TRUMP LOSS

The following was recorded on November 24,

1 R E C O R D I N G

2 ANNOUNCER: This is the Eric Metaxas Show.

3 ERIC METAXAS: Hey, there, folks. I've got a
4 big surprise for you. We had to kick my dear friend,
5 Dick Morris to the curb, because I think that we need
6 to talk about something else today. Maybe we'll talk
7 to Dick tomorrow.

8 But some of you have heard the story of Joe
9 Oltmann. Joe Oltmann, O-l-t-m-a-n [sic], was all over
10 the news not long ago talking about how he came across
11 a guy named Eric Coomer, who is affiliated with
12 Dominion, and how this Eric Coomer also seems to be so
13 viciously, insanely anti-Trump that Eric Coomer of
14 Dominion is also involved with Antifa. We just thought
15 we'd get Joe Oltmann to tell the story.

16 Joe Oltmann, welcome to this program.

17 JOE OLTMANN: Hey, thanks for having me.

18 ERIC METAXAS: Okay. So folks who know
19 nothing about this, first of all, who are you? What is
20 your background? How do you come to bump into somebody
21 like Eric Coomer of Dominion?

22 JOE OLTMANN: So I'm a CEO of tech company
23 based out of Denver, Colorado. We're a -- we're a data
24 company. And you know, I -- I don't -- I guess I can
25 go back and tell you that -- that normally I'd stay --

1 I've stayed as far out of politics as possible, at
2 least personally. I've been involved in obviously
3 giving to different things, but I started an
4 organization called FEC United in Colorado, and -- that
5 works off of faith, education, and commerce, the
6 pillars of our society, when they basically started
7 taking away constitutional rights of people in
8 communities.

9 So that kind of led to, and I can kind of --
10 I mean, if you want I can just tell you the story of
11 how I got involved and -- and how it even got on my
12 radar. It's very serendipitous. I -- I didn't set
13 out --

14 ERIC METAXAS: I mean, that's why your story
15 is interesting, because you weren't looking for this,
16 you're -- you're not political. I mean, you are a
17 person of faith, the way I am, but you -- you were just
18 doing something else and something comes across your
19 radar. You were like what, on a Zoom call or
20 something?

21 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah. So something like that.
22 They had a conference call. So I'll kind of back up.
23 I -- I -- back in late September, middle to late
24 September, we had been, because of the work we had been
25 doing on reopening Colorado and kind of stopping, you

1 know, businesses from basically being crushed while --
2 while big businesses were given basically a Black
3 Friday event for many months and small businesses and
4 people in [glitch on recording] businesses were being
5 [glitch on recording].

6 We had these Antifa journalists all over
7 Colorado that started writing articles about FEC
8 United, about me personally, and about an organization
9 that we partner with called UADF, United American
10 Defense Force, John Tiegen, who is frankly an American
11 hero, is the one that heads up that organization. And
12 that just works to bring people in the community
13 together to protect their community against people who
14 would lee -- loot, steel, rob, burn buildings to the --

15 ERIC METAXAS: I have a question. Why would
16 Antifa take issue with what you were doing? Like
17 that's interesting to me. In other words, you know,
18 I -- I -- I know what they hate, but it doesn't seem
19 that what you were doing -- what you were doing is kind
20 of just some basic stuff. How does that -- how does
21 that get political for them? I don't get that.

22 JOE OLTMANN: Well, the -- I think the -- the
23 big issue for them is the fact that we stood up pretty
24 strong against Antifa and -- and against anyone that
25 would basically hurt people in our community, and we're

1 standing up against this kind of far left agenda that
2 seems to be permeating in a very short period of time
3 our society.

4 ERIC METAXAS: Correct.

5 JOE OLTMANN: But once you get on somebody's
6 radar, they frankly just kind of collect together and
7 just write as many bad things about you as possible.

8 ERIC METAXAS: It's happened to me. I get
9 it. It's -- it's where we are right now. So think of
10 it as a badge of honor.

11 So -- okay. So where were you when this guy
12 Eric Coomer of Dominion comes across your radar?

13 JOE OLTMANN: So I was looking for Antifa
14 journalists. I was looking for journalists that I
15 could basically out as activists and not just people
16 that were actually doing journalism.

17 And so I -- I had a group of people and we
18 infiltrated Antifa. We infiltrated their meetings, we
19 infiltrated their conference calls, we got information
20 about what they were planning to do next. Not because
21 I really wanted that, but I just wanted to figure out,
22 you know, how they operate.

23 And around this same time, by the way, you
24 remember the -- the Project Veritas story that came out
25 with -- about Kris Jacks, the guy from Our Revolution,

1 who said that he wanted to kill Americans in the street
2 and that they would lie, cheat, and steal in order to
3 get the results.

4 So I wanted to know what I was up against
5 with Antifa. They had written an article saying that I
6 was far right extremist. I'm the farthest thing from
7 far right, by the way. I -- I -- I sit on boards that
8 are left-leaning, bringing some sensibility to things
9 that they do. I give an enormous amount of money to
10 nonprofits for inner city youth, for education,
11 medical, a number of things.

12 And so I found myself on this phone call,
13 this conference call, and, you know, this guy named
14 Eric started talking. And then somebody asked who Eric
15 was. And they said Eric's a Dominion guy, right? And
16 so I just started --

17 ERIC METAXAS: Now, excuse me, were you -- at
18 this point, were you yourself, or were you kind of
19 lurking on an Antifa meeting?

20 JOE OLTMANN: They had -- they had no idea I
21 was there.

22 ERIC METAXAS: Okay. So -- so that's the
23 key. So you're kind of -- you're kind of hiding.
24 You've infiltrated Antifa and you're watching the
25 meeting, it's an Antifa meeting. This guy Eric Coomer

1 comes into the meeting. Somebody says, who's Eric
2 Coomer? One of these Antifa people says, who's Eric
3 Coomer? And they say, oh, he's with Dominion. So --

4 JOE OLTMANN: They never -- they never said
5 the word "Coomer," right? It was just Eric. Who's
6 Eric? And then Eric is the Dominion guy. So I just
7 wrote "Dominion Eric," I just wrote that down. I
8 really wasn't looking for him. I didn't -- I didn't
9 know the significance of him at all. I -- I still,
10 even after I got off that call, didn't know the
11 significance of it.

12 But then he starts -- they -- they -- you
13 know, tell him to keep -- that he can keep going on, go
14 ahead. Somebody interrupts, What are we going to do if
15 Trump wins, something to that effect. And I'm
16 paraphrasing this, right? So I didn't write down word
17 for word what he said. But Eric responds, Don't worry
18 about the election. Trump's not going to win. I've
19 made effing sure of that. So --

20 ERIC METAXAS: Okay. He made effing sure of
21 that. "Effing" means very, very.

22 Now, let me ask you, for my audience, who is
23 Eric Coomer now? Publicly who is this guy?

24 JOE OLTMANN: So he is the Director of
25 Strategy and Security for Dominion Voting Systems.

1 ERIC METAXAS: Okay. Stop. That's the
2 headline, right?

3 JOE OLTMANN: Right.

4 ERIC METAXAS: He's not some guy with
5 Dominion.

6 JOE OLTMANN: Right.

7 ERIC METAXAS: He is the head of, say it
8 again.

9 JOE OLTMANN: Dominion Voting Systems.

10 ERIC METAXAS: No, but he is the head of?

11 JOE OLTMANN: I'm sorry. He is the Director
12 of Strategy and Security at Dominion Voting Systems.
13 He's --[inaudible due to talking at the same time]

14 ERIC METAXAS: Okay. So if there's anybody
15 out there who believes that Dominion is just a company
16 that does voting machines, their Director of Strategy
17 and Security despises Donald Trump. That is what came
18 clear to you as you're lurking in this Antifa meeting?

19 JOE OLTMANN: Yes. Well, actually, that's
20 not how I actually discovered all of this stuff. I
21 didn't know what it was.

22 So right after the call, I got the
23 information out of it that I needed. And in my mind,
24 when he said it, I started laughing, because I was like
25 these guys are crazy. They think they can just will an

1 election any way they want like they're Jedi warriors.

2 I actually said that. And I walked back --

3 ERIC METAXAS: Did you know who Dominion was
4 at the time?

5 JOE OLTMANN: No idea.

6 ERIC METAXAS: Yeah, no -- nobody did. Okay.
7 Go ahead.

8 JOE OLTMANN: And -- and so I got off the
9 call. And I'm -- I didn't actually have to use a whole
10 lot of data to do this. It wasn't very clever. I just
11 put into Google "Eric Dominion Denver Colorado."
12 That's it. That's all I did. And up pops, you know,
13 Eric Coomer, Dominion Voting Systems. I did a little
14 bit of research, found out that he has a doctorate from
15 Cal Berkeley in nuclear physics. He's a mastermind in
16 coding.

17 ERIC METAXAS: A doctorate -- he's a PhD in
18 nuclear physics. So this is a super brilliant guy,
19 Director of Strategy and Security. Now, when you're
20 talking about Dominion Voting Systems, there is no
21 higher level of security necessary, you know, it's like
22 the guy, who we had on this program recently, who
23 created the -- the -- the antifraud system for eBay.

24 JOE OLTMANN: Right.

25 ERIC METAXAS: I mean, this is top, top, top

1 level coding and that stuff.

2 So this guy, Eric Coomer, this genius, you
3 discover was the -- the guy who said on this Antifa
4 call, Don't worry about Trump, there's no way he's
5 going to win.

6 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah. And I've also tied him
7 to Our Revolution, the movement. I've tied him to
8 other things.

9 But even at that point, I did not understand
10 what I was looking at. I didn't understand the
11 significance of Dominion Voting Systems. I didn't
12 actually even get involved in and even going any
13 further, I just set that information aside, because I
14 was looking for Antifa journalists. And I was able to
15 uncover quite a few Antifa journalists over a very
16 short period of time.

17 ERIC METAXAS: And when you say that, you
18 mean journalists, who are playing the role of
19 journalists but who are, in fact, are activists for
20 Antifa.

21 JOE OLTMANN: Correct. Correct. And --

22 ERIC METAXAS: As if that wasn't disturbing
23 enough, we're going to put that to the side, right?

24 JOE OLTMANN: And -- and -- and -- and the --
25 the scary part about that is, is that as you start

1 uncovering who these people are and how they're
2 connected with other people inside of things like the
3 Humane Society, that they're gathering information
4 there that can use to dox people that disagree with
5 them. They -- they became journalists for the Business
6 Journal, where they gather even more information about
7 people's companies.

8 ERIC METAXAS: Folks, we'll be right back
9 with Joe Oltmann.

10 (Break in podcast.)

11 ERIC METAXAS: Folks, I'm talking to Joe
12 Oltmann. In case you're not fascinated by this, you're
13 clearly not listening very carefully, so I'd like you
14 to go back and listen to our previous segment. This is
15 insane.

16 Joe Oltmann, you are -- you're a little tough
17 to describe, but I guess the point is you're an
18 entrepreneur, you build businesses, but you're also a
19 patriot, a man of faith, you got involved in some stuff
20 and you understood that Antifa was a threat to America,
21 you infiltrated Antifa meetings, which is utterly
22 heroic and fascinating and wonderful and thrilling
23 and -- and inspirational to everybody listening,
24 frankly.

25 And in the course of that, you come across

1 this guy named Eric Coomer, whom you've described,
2 Director of Strategy and Security at Dominion Voting
3 Systems. The man is pro Antifa, despises not just
4 Donald Trump, but it seems to me if you're pro Antifa,
5 despises America. So where do we go from here? You
6 were referring to this meeting in October, okay, so it
7 was a month ago --

8 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah.

9 ERIC METAXAS: -- where you made this
10 statement. So what happens?

11 JOE OLTMANN: But I still didn't know who
12 Eric Coomer was. It still wasn't -- to me, none of
13 that actually made any difference to me. I didn't -- I
14 put him aside. I just thought that he maybe worked for
15 the CIA or the FBI. I did not feel that I was dealing
16 with someone that was Antifa material.

17 You know, fast forward to the election. We
18 all know, we went to -- we went to sleep that night
19 thinking, okay, Trump actually has won this, it's going
20 to be fine. We wake up in the morning to a totally
21 different story, right? And what was odd about that
22 night is that -- that the networks looked like they
23 were working together to not call the election, right?
24 Very strange, right?

25 And then if you go back -- so regardless of

1 that, get passed that. We all knew that there was
2 something funny that was up. We saw, you know, big
3 batches of -- of ballots come through at one time at
4 2 o'clock in the morning, and then the -- the fraud
5 allegations started rolling in.

6 Well, I went elk hunting on Friday. And I'm
7 up elk hunting in Southern Colorado, in the mountains.
8 And I get a text message from someone with an article.
9 And so I'm -- I'm reading the article, which I normally
10 wouldn't do, I get hundreds of e-mails or texts a day.
11 I just kind of look at it and then didn't respond to
12 something.

13 But I actually read this article, and in it,
14 it talked about in Georgia how the election machines
15 went down for a couple hours while an update was
16 installed in the middle of the election day. And if
17 that's not strange enough, as I get further down, Eric
18 Coomer pops up as a spokesperson for Dominion Voting
19 Systems. So at that point my stomach sank, and I go,
20 oh, my gosh, that's -- I remember that guy, right?

21 So at that point --

22 ERIC METAXAS: So this is -- you're literally
23 elk hunting at this point.

24 JOE OLTMANN: Right.

25 ERIC METAXAS: Reading your phone.

1 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah.

2 ERIC METAXAS: Okay. So the elk obviously
3 get to live another day --

4 JOE OLTMANN: They did, at that point.

5 ERIC METAXAS: -- when you realize --

6 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah.

7 ERIC METAXAS: -- that something almost
8 unbelievable is happening.

9 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah. So -- so at that point,
10 I started doing research on Eric Coomer and Dominion
11 Voting Systems. I still, at this point, this is after
12 the election, I did not know that Dominion Voting
13 Systems was in 40 states. I did know that they had
14 their grasp between 23 and 28 states. I didn't know --
15 I didn't know any of that up to this point.

16 So the more research I did, the more I
17 started seeing Eric Coomer's name come up everywhere.
18 It came up in every RFP, in all the swing states, from
19 Arizona to Nevada to Georgia to Pennsylvania; when they
20 actually pulled the RFP from certain parts of
21 Pennsylvania, to Michigan, to Wisconsin. Everywhere I
22 looked, Eric Coomer's name came up.

23 I started researching lawsuits in different
24 states, that he was the expert witness being propped up
25 by Dominion Voting Systems. So he became the proxy for

1 Dominion Voting Systems everywhere.

2 So at that point, I -- I had tied him to
3 Antifa. I didn't have any proof at that point, but I
4 had all this information that showed that -- that he
5 was -- that, in my opinion, he was a bad actor.

6 So I said to myself, I need to get access to
7 his social media accounts. So I started basically
8 correlating his Twitter accounts and his Reddit
9 accounts and all the different accounts that he had
10 everywhere. And I got behind his Facebook account.
11 And it was then when I got actually behind and started
12 looking at the posts on his Facebook account that
13 everything kind of came together, that we were dealing
14 with a person that could put his finger firmly on the
15 American voice and tip the scale of the election very
16 easily. And that -- and that, frankly, that -- that --
17 that he was doing it.

18 So on June 2nd, he posted the Antifa
19 Manifesto on his Facebook page. On May 31st, he put up
20 posts basically that say eff the police, eff the
21 U.S.A., dead prez. These are -- these are videos, and
22 if you go watch them on YouTube, you would be just
23 amazed at the type of language.

24 You traced all of his Facebook posts, all the
25 way back to 2016, and it was the most vile anti-Trump

1 rants that you could possibly see a person go on.
2 And -- and frankly, it was scary. It was sociopathic.
3 Like it just -- it didn't seem like the -- the rantings
4 of a -- of a sane individual.

5 ERIC METAXAS: Well, I was going to say, you
6 know, when you're smart enough to get a PhD in nuclear
7 physics, it, you know, reminds me of the -- the
8 Unabomber. There's some people that they're learning
9 -- or rather their -- their -- their -- their brains
10 can really -- they'll flirt with -- with insanity and
11 violence. And it -- it sounds like you're dealing with
12 somebody who at least begins to fall into that
13 category. I mean, we know that Antifa is -- is evil,
14 that they are anti-American, that they are effectively
15 Marxist shock troops at this point. But to have a man
16 with this kind of power, the Director of Strategy And
17 Security at Dominion, huge, powerful, international
18 company. This is big news.

19 Now, we're going to have to hold it there for
20 today. We will continue this on the radio program
21 tomorrow. If people want to listen to the rest of my
22 conversation with Joe Oltmann, folks, go to our YouTube
23 channel. We'll post that today. It's probably already
24 posted as you hear my voice. It's the Eric Metaxas
25 Show on YouTube. This is a very, very important

1 conversation. Joe, thank you. We will continue the
2 conversation in just a moment.

3 (Break in podcast.)

4 ERIC METAXAS: Folks, I'm continuing my
5 conversation with Joe Oltmann. Just to reprise, and
6 forgive me always for reprising, but, Joe, you are a
7 businessman who, because of your faith and your --
8 your -- your love of country, you got involved in
9 trying to see what's going on with Antifa. And as a
10 result of your efforts, you came across this dude named
11 Eric Coomer whom -- who -- who you had no idea until
12 later was the Director of Strategy and Security for
13 Dominion Voting Systems who's all in for Antifa. You
14 say he posted their -- their -- their manifesto on his
15 website like way back in June. This is scary stuff.
16 Somebody who has that level of tremendous power, who's
17 all in for Antifa.

18 So when you figured all this out, what did
19 you do?

20 JOE OLTMANN: First of all, I started digging
21 in and uncovering things like patents and the patents
22 that he had assigned to Dominion Voting Systems. I
23 looked at his history. If you get further down, I
24 started looking at places that Eric Coomer had
25 traveled. And then I started looking at irregularities

1 of the Dominion Voting Systems in different countries
2 that -- that -- that frankly that Eric was.

3 So I -- I traced him all the way back to
4 2012, to Mongolia. They had a massive election issue
5 and they had used the Dominion Voting System in their
6 country. And guess who sold them the Dominion Voting
7 Systems software?

8 ERIC METAXAS: Can I guess Eric Coomer? I'll
9 try, Eric Coomer.

10 JOE OLTMANN: So --

11 ERIC METAXAS: I mean, this is globalist
12 stuff. In other words, this is like everybody's worst
13 nightmare of Deep State, George Soros. The idea that a
14 man of this level at a place like Dominion, which is
15 operating all around the globe in elections, which got
16 started in Venezuela, that somebody like that who
17 despises America and who -- you know, if you despise
18 America, by definition you become allied with these
19 globalist forces which are effectively fascists,
20 Marxist, you know, that -- that -- that this guy has
21 this kind of power. I mean, it's scary even just
22 having this conversation with you, thinking about this.
23 And if I didn't have a strong faith, I really would be
24 scared, but I'm not.

25 So what did you do with this information? In

1 other words, did you take this information to Sidney
2 Powell? What did you do with this information?

3 JOE OLTMANN: You know, I founded an
4 organization called Conservative Daily. And I used the
5 media personality Joe Otto. We started a podcast six
6 months ago that, frankly, has become one of the really
7 most popular political podcasts now in the nation.

8 So I took it there first. I said, listen, I
9 want to -- I want to take a two-hour segment. I'm
10 going to tell you the story about Eric Coomer. And so
11 I did that. And then from there I started posting
12 things on Twitter. Twitter then basically --

13 ERIC METAXAS: But this is like what, ten
14 days ago?

15 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah.

16 ERIC METAXAS: I mean, this just happened.
17 This is like ten days ago, after the election.

18 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah.

19 ERIC METAXAS: So at what point does this get
20 picked up and who picked it up?

21 JOE OLTMANN: So then Michelle Malkin picked
22 it up. Once she picked it up, I did an interview with
23 her. Then Twitter shut down my Twitter feed. Eric
24 Coomer started basically scraping the internet of his
25 name. I mean, literally taking everything Eric Coomer

1 off the internet. Everything. And Dominion took them
2 off their website, they took him off of LeadCandy,
3 they -- they basically went into archives to delete his
4 information in places you didn't think were possible.

5 ERIC METAXAS: Has anybody reported this?
6 Who has reported this?

7 JOE OLTMANN: So -- so I reported it,
8 Michelle has reported it, some other people have
9 reported it. I -- I got in touch with the Trump
10 campaign and the Trump attorneys. I talked to people
11 like Sidney Powell, actually I talked to Sidney Powell,
12 but getting as much of this information in their hands
13 as possible. I've been in constant contact with the
14 Trump attorneys. I've done probably a dozen or so
15 video interviews and probably two or three dozen radio
16 interviews. I continually push that information out,
17 give that information to --

18 ERIC METAXAS: But -- but what I'm saying is
19 that you've -- okay. So you're getting this
20 information into their hands, which is the most
21 important thing.

22 But, you know, for -- for -- for my audience,
23 it's just fascinating to think that here we are talking
24 about this, and this is not widely known. This seems
25 to me to be so extremely important that it is

1 surprising to me that Fox News has not covered it. Has
2 Tucker Carlson mentioned any of this stuff?

3 JOE OLTMANN: No. The closest it came is
4 when -- was when Sidney Powell, on her interviews,
5 stated that there's an affidavit signed. That was my
6 affidavit. So I did sign an affidavit.

7 ERIC METAXAS: Signed to what effect? To --
8 to what, of all -- all of these things?

9 JOE OLTMANN: All these things, all the
10 information that I'm giving you.

11 And then, frankly, I just started using more
12 of the tools that I had in order to create more
13 information for -- for different media sources and the
14 attorneys.

15 ERIC METAXAS: Now, is that affidavit not
16 public because they don't want the other side to know
17 what they're cooking up, here? I mean, is it --

18 JOE OLTMANN: Well, I -- I think that -- for
19 me, it's already become a security risk. I have two
20 guards that are guarding my family at this point.
21 The -- the threats have rolled in, the -- you know, I
22 find --

23 ERIC METAXAS: You're over the target.
24 You're over the target.

25 JOE OLTMANN: Very much over the target.

1 And I'm also not a -- a fearful person. So I
2 believe that God will protect me and what God can't
3 protect on one side, I -- I believe in the Second
4 Amendment, so I'll play -- I'll protect the other side
5 (laughter).

6 ERIC METAXAS: Yeah.

7 JOE OLTMANN: A little bit of humor in the
8 middle of all of this.

9 ERIC METAXAS: Yeah. Do you think birdshot
10 will cover it or do you have more -- bigger -- bigger
11 weapons?

12 JOE OLTMANN: Among other things, I own -- I
13 own quite a few companies, and one of them is a gun
14 store and range, so I think I'm pretty well protected.

15 ERIC METAXAS: All right. I like what I'm
16 hearing. I like what I'm hearing. Okay.

17 So the -- the biggest -- what are the biggest
18 interviews you've done, because what you're telling me
19 is so big that I -- I just -- you said you've spoken on
20 Michelle Malkin's program?

21 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah.

22 ERIC METAXAS: Have you spoken to any other
23 main national programs?

24 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah. OAN did a segment on it.
25 I've done -- I don't know how big everyone is. Again,

1 I'm an introvert, I'm not an extrovert. So I'm -- I'm
2 not one of those people that just runs out there and
3 tries to put the story out there. I'm not actually --
4 I'm doing as much as I can to put it out there and
5 giving it to people like you who have influence, have
6 the ability to tell the story, but there's two things
7 that I don't need: I don't need notoriety and I don't
8 need money. So this just goes against everything
9 that -- that -- you know, a person -- person like --
10 like me would want to do, right? I'm -- and I'm only
11 doing it not because, you know, I support Trump,
12 because I do. I do want you to know, I support my
13 President 100 percent.

14 But because what's more important than
15 supporting President Trump is making sure that the
16 American voice is actually heard. Making sure that --
17 that whatever the -- the people of this country vote
18 for, that is the will of the people. And for somebody
19 to put their finger on that scale and tip that scale
20 away from the voice of the American people turns us
21 from a constitutional republic to, frankly, a communist
22 society. So it's -- it's very --

23 ERIC METAXAS: That's -- look, that's exactly
24 why I'm so exercised about this. The idea, the idea
25 that anyone would dare to try to mess with our

1 elections, many patriots have died, suffered and died
2 so that we could have what we have. And I cannot think
3 of anything more despicable and more worthy of our
4 doing everything we can, including give our lives, if
5 necessary, to fight for this.

6 And so that's why I'm so glad to be speaking
7 with you and getting this information out. People need
8 to understand. I keep saying we needed a thousand Paul
9 Reveres to get this information out. This is utterly
10 unacceptable. There's no way that anyone will accept
11 the presidency of Joe Biden under this black cloud now.
12 You know, unless -- unless they can prove that this was
13 a fair election, there is no way the American people,
14 with all this evidence coming out, are going to accept
15 it. So --

16 JOE OLTMANN: Well, we have -- we have a
17 bigger problem, and that is we are ignoring science and
18 math, right? We're ignoring those two things. If you
19 use Benford law, which a -- is a law of -- of anomalies
20 and -- and -- and statistical improbabilities, it will
21 actually tell you that there's massive amounts of
22 fraud.

23 There's people that are coming out that are
24 MIT PhDs in mathematics, that are being silenced.
25 There's -- there's a weaponization of technology in the

1 media like we've never seen before, that has this
2 concerted effort in order to silence people like me and
3 others that are coming forward with information that is
4 massive amounts of proof. Yet they say -- keep saying
5 that there's no proof, there's no proof, there's no
6 proof.

7 Look, the smoking gun is -- is actually
8 pieces and parts of the gun that they've walked through
9 security, to the other side. So as you take the piece
10 that I have and put it together with other pieces, it's
11 undeniable that we have massive amounts of voter fraud
12 in this country. And you have a concerted effort by --
13 you -- you want to call it the "Deep State," I don't
14 know what to call it, other than people that are
15 anti-American that have come together with the idea
16 that they can destroy the very fiber of what our
17 country represents.

18 ERIC METAXAS: These are -- these are people
19 working on the side of evil. Let's cut to the chase.
20 This is satanic evil. Anybody who wants to cheat and
21 lie, we know that's wrong. But when you cheat and lie
22 as a way to shut down the voice of American voters,
23 that rises to a whole new level, because this country
24 has been the shining torch of freedom for the whole
25 world. So we're affecting -- it -- of course, it

1 affects the whole world. We -- we know that. We don't
2 need to get into that.

3 You're not looking for publicity or money.
4 Unfortunately, I'm looking for both, so I need to talk
5 to you offline. Just -- just kidding.

6 But the fact is that -- so it's not like you
7 want me to send people to your website or something.
8 You said you have -- what is the podcast?

9 JOE OLTMANN: It's Conservative Daily
10 Podcast.

11 ERIC METAXAS: Okay. That -- that's the
12 least we can do. We're going to go to a break. We'll
13 continue this conversation. Folks, I'm talking to Joe
14 Oltmann, O-l-t-m-a-n [sic]. We'll be right back.

15 (Break in podcast.)

16 ERIC METAXAS: Folks, I'm talking to Joe
17 Oltmann, O-l-t-m-a-n-n, two n's at the end, there.

18 Okay. Joe, you uncover something so huge,
19 you weren't looking for this, you stumble onto the fact
20 that a guy named Eric Coomer is the Director of
21 Strategy and Security for Dominion Voting Systems.
22 Absolutely monstrous job. You've got to be a super
23 genius to -- to understand that world of -- of fraud
24 and -- and coding, and all this different stuff. And
25 then you discover that that guy is all in for Antifa,

1 wants to do anything he can with his tremendously
2 powerful position to make sure Donald Trump is not
3 elected.

4 He effectively succeeds because we wake up on
5 the 4th of November and find out that, hey, well, what
6 happened, what happened? And then this stuff leaks out
7 and that kind of leads you on your path.

8 So where are you now, and where is this now?
9 Does this -- all this information just sit with -- with
10 Sidney Powell and others in that this is going to be
11 part of the case that they bring maybe before the
12 Supreme Court?

13 JOE OLTMANN: Yeah. So I want you to know
14 that I'm giving the information to everyone, right? So
15 I'm -- I'm talking to people, you know, from
16 Congressmen, to different committees in Congress, to
17 people in the DOJ, I've sent this information to.

18 Obviously people have -- have reached out to
19 you and said, hey, you need to have a conversation with
20 this guy. So I literally spend all day putting as much
21 of this information out there as possible.

22 I even have Snopes that basically reached out
23 to me and tried to intimidate me into giving them the
24 information or else. To which they actually posted
25 something that says that what I have said is unproven.

1 I don't actually know how you can say that what I said
2 is unproven. But they -- he said that if I didn't give
3 it to them by 1 o'clock in the -- in the afternoon,
4 that they were -- it was -- again, it was an or-else
5 type of environment.

6 ERIC METAXAS: Oh, Snopes. We all know
7 Snopes is kind of a joke at this point. And it's a
8 pity because, you know, five years ago, I thought, hey,
9 I'm so glad they exist. But they're -- they're left
10 wing and you can't really take them very seriously.

11 Eric Coomer, has he gone into hiding? What
12 is -- what is he thinking? Does he know he's going to
13 go to prison for the rest of his life?

14 JOE OLTMANN: The scary part about all of
15 this is that Eric Coomer is a ghost, right? So I -- I
16 do know that -- and again, it's more morbid curiosity
17 on my side to basically track what he's doing, what
18 he's saying, and how he's engaging in different
19 environments. So I am still watching those things.

20 I'm watching right now as different states
21 take their RFPs. And Colorado, they -- they literally
22 redacted everything that had Eric Coomer on the RFP
23 document that Dominion --

24 ERIC METAXAS: What is RFP? What is that?

25 JOE OLTMANN: Request for proposal, so it's

1 basically a brief that -- that has to be public --
2 public information. So Jena Griswold actually -- well,
3 went in and actually -- she's the Secretary of State of
4 Colorado, and removed the RFP, got rid of it, put it in
5 a different place, redacted information that actually
6 tied Smartmatic, Venezuela, and Eric Coomer to the
7 document, and then uploaded other documents, forgetting
8 about the fact that the other documents that they
9 uploaded, that were dated back in 2017, had the wrong
10 address on them.

11 So there -- there isn't -- I'm telling you
12 right now, if you tie all this together, there -- there
13 is -- there is something just cynical happening across
14 the country to -- to the American people.

15 And -- and while media is actually out there
16 saying that there's nothing to see here. I mean,
17 even -- even Michael Steel, the PR guy that actually
18 represents -- that represents Dominion Voting Systems,
19 came out and said, oh, their system can't do that.

20 Right before the -- the -- Dominion was
21 supposed to testify in front of the legislative body
22 for Pennsylvania, I was called by one of the
23 Congressmen and said, hey, can you provide information?
24 I provided that information to that Congressman, he
25 provided that information to the legislative body, and

1 then all of a sudden, two-and-a-half hours later,
2 the -- they said, hey, we -- we're not going to --
3 we're not going to show up.

4 I was asked to write questions for the
5 legislative body to ask Dominion Voting Systems about
6 irregularities. I wrote a list of questions, and they
7 decided that they -- they were going to lawyer up.

8 Why, if there's no fraud against the American
9 people, has Eric Coomer disappeared? Why are they
10 redacting information all over the internet? Why is
11 Dominion packing up their offices? They packed up
12 their Denver office, they packed up the Toronto office.
13 The Toronto office is actually one -- is on the same
14 floor as Soros's nonprofit.

15 So this isn't all made up. This isn't
16 hyperbole that we're just throwing out there. This is
17 absolute fact. And why is Twitter cutting me off? Why
18 did they actually make up some bogus claim that I had
19 multiple Twitter accounts, when I've only had one
20 Twitter account. I didn't even like Twitter, nor did I
21 even use it --

22 ERIC METAXAS: Yeah.

23 JOE OLTMANN: -- until two weeks ago.

24 ERIC METAXAS: Well, there's levels of
25 stupidity and evil, and we know that not everybody is

1 on the same level, that there are some people that they
2 just hate Trump. But then there are other nefarious
3 actors, like Mr. Coomer and others, who -- you know,
4 they're -- it's hard to know what to say other than
5 there's -- there's wickedness. There's evil here,
6 because nothing that they're doing, even if you hate
7 Trump, I have many friends who hate Trump --

8 JOE OLTMANN: Right.

9 ERIC METAXAS: -- but they would never do
10 what we're talking about. What we're talking about is
11 evil. In fact, let's just say this, it's extremely
12 criminal, and these folks know they're going to go to
13 jail for the rest of their lives. It doesn't matter
14 how rich or smart they are, that they are in the
15 process of being caught, thanks to God, because you
16 were just -- you just stumbled across this. God chose
17 you to stumble across this to get this information out.

18 I'm very encouraged by your mere existence,
19 Joe Oltmann, just to know that you are who you are and
20 doing what you're doing, I'm really encouraged, as I
21 say. It seems to me that there's -- there's a lot more
22 here, maybe we will save this for another time when
23 you're not pheasant hunting, but I just -- I just -- I
24 thank God for you, I know my audience thanks God for
25 you, and for knowing what's going on. And it gives us

1 a lot of hope for these lawsuits that -- that -- that
2 lie ahead. Thank you.

3 JOE OLTMANN: All right. Thank you. God
4 bless you and God bless your audience. And God bless
5 our President. We need to pray for him. We need to
6 pray for our country.

7 ERIC METAXAS: We are doing that. We're
8 doing prayer calls every other night, big prayer calls.
9 I'll tell you about that in a moment, but we're going
10 to -- we'll end this segment. Thank you.

11 (Break in podcast.)

12 ERIC METAXAS: Quick question: Do you share
13 the values of the people who sell you things?

14 MIKE LINDELL: Hello, I'm Mike Lindell.

15 ERIC METAXAS: I can tell you that I do. I
16 love Mike Lindell. And not just Mike Lindell, but what
17 he stands for.

18 MIKE LINDELL: And I encourage you to use
19 this time at home to get back in the Word, read our
20 bibles and spend time with our families.

21 ERIC METAXAS: The dude said that at the
22 White House. How can you not love him?

23 HILLARY CLINTON: What difference, at this
24 point, does it make?

25 ERIC METAXAS: No, actually it does make a

1 difference. How you spend your money is as important
2 as how you vote. And you don't want to, you know, help
3 elect some crazy guy, do you?

4 JOE BIDEN: You may cut me, man, but I'm
5 going to wrap this chain around your head.

6 ERIC METAXAS: Did -- did he just say that?

7 JOE BIDEN: If you fell off sideways, you
8 landed on the damn -- the darn cement.

9 ERIC METAXAS: So if you want your money to
10 support good things, visit mypillow.com.

11 JOE BIDEN: Corn Pop was a bad dude.

12 ERIC METAXAS: And please use the discount
13 code "Eric" or "Metaxas."

14 JOE BIDEN: If you used pomade in your hair,
15 you had to wear a bathing cap.

16 ERIC METAXAS: A bathing cap? Anyway, please
17 go to mypillow.com and use the code "Eric" or
18 "Metaxas."

19 JOE BIDEN: Corn Pop was a bad dude.

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
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
