The following Affidavit is submitted to the Court to document the probable cause in support of a request for the issuance of an Arrest Warrant for:

**Breeana Eloise Dahlberg, SSN:                      DOB: 09/02/1996, White female, 5'06", 180 lbs, brown hair, blue eyes, Defendant.**

This offense is fully documented in Offense Report(s) \_\_\_\_\_, detailing the offense(s) of:

**C.R.S. 18-3-302(1)(3)(b)(II) Second Degree Kidnapping, 1 count, a class 3 felony.**

Your Affiant is Detective Rosario S. Hubbell #07050, a regularly employed Deputy Sheriff for the County of El Paso, State of Colorado, who is currently assigned as a Detective to the Investigations Division, Major Crimes Unit of the El Paso County Sheriff's Office. Your Affiant will be referred to as "I" for the remainder of this affidavit.

While performing follow-up for a homicide investigation (EPSO Case \_\_\_\_\_), on March 15, 2017, I was present when Detective Kurt Smith performed an interview with Ranyin Vargas (DOB 12/26/97). Ms. Vargas informed Detective Smith that she received screenshots of Facebook Messenger posts from a suspect named Joseph Rodriguez (DOB 8/5/98), which described kidnapping a friend named \_\_\_\_\_. Ms. Vargas stated she saw a picture of \_\_\_\_\_ holding a sign that said, "Me, \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ stole from them."

At approximately 4:15 PM, I, conducted and interview with \_\_\_\_\_ at the Office of the Sheriff (OTS), 27 E. Vermijo Avenue, Colorado Springs, El Paso County, State of Colorado. \_\_\_\_\_ mother also attended the interview.

During the interview, \_\_\_\_\_ stated that she was visiting at 2242 E. Bijou Street, Colorado Springs, El Paso County, State of Colorado, on February 27, 2017, at approximately 4:00 AM. That address is the residence for Endo Velarde (aka Sleepy DOB 7/3/98),

Joseph Rodriguez (aka Joey), Angelita Prado (aka Lita), and Alexandra Romero (aka Lexi) were also present at the address. While in a back room of the apartment, [redacted] was asked to walk out to a truck in the parking lot, while Mr. Rodriguez walked beside her while carrying a large metal pipe. Mr. Rodriguez made a statement that he carried the pole because he "didn't have his strap". Strap is a common street term for pistol.

[redacted] said she rode in the truck from the apartment to a nearby 7-11 Store with Ms. Prada and Mr. Rodriguez. While at the 7-11 store, Ms. Prada took [redacted] cell-phone away, and told [redacted] that the phone would be searched. Mr. Rodriguez placed a blindfold on [redacted] face preventing her from seeing.

[redacted] described being transported to an unknown hotel room. Ms. Romero, Mr. Rodriguez, and Ms. Prada were present in the hotel room. Ms. Romero began to assault [redacted] by punching her in the face and "tazing" her with a pink tazer. [redacted] was questioned about giving out an address associated with a gang shooting at the nearby "Rustic" apartments. All three suspects threatened to assault [redacted] if she ran from the hotel room. While in the hotel, the suspects searched through [redacted] cell phone looking for evidence that she released certain information.

After several hours at the hotel room, [redacted] was blindfolded again and walked back out to the pickup. Mr. Rodriguez pushed [redacted] head down while in the truck to keep her out of view. [redacted] stated that her leg feel asleep due to the position she was forced into.

[redacted] described being driven to an unknown house with multiple unknown adults and children. While at the house, [redacted] was ordered to watch after the kids in the house. [redacted] was unable to provide an address but described it as a townhome style apartment with a brown fence around a small yard. [redacted] stated that she later escaped and ran away from the house. [redacted] never recovered her cell-phone.

On Friday, March 24, 2017, Detective Tremain White performed an interview with Alexandra Romero DOB: 6/6/95, at the OTS. Ms. Romero corroborated [redacted] account, even admitting to punching [redacted] in the face and using a pink tazer on [redacted] Ms. Romero was later booked into CJC in for charges in connection with the homicide of [redacted] and [redacted] and for the kidnapping of [redacted]

On Tuesday March 28, 2017, I conducted a voluntary interview with Breeana Eloise Dahlberg DOB: 09/02/1996. Ms. Dahlberg confirmed her address as 2133 Delta Drive Apt #E, Colorado Springs, El Paso County, State of Colorado. This address is the Whitney Young Manor, Townhome style apartments with a rear entry and small yard surrounded by a brown six foot privacy fence. Ms. Dahlberg confirmed Ms. Romero and Mr. Rodriguez arrived at Ms. Dahlberg's residence with an unknown female, later identified as [redacted] Ms. Romero told Ms.

Dahlberg the female was a hostage and was there to watch the kids. Ms. Dahlberg was told to watch her and not let her go.

Ms. Dahlberg was informed that \_\_\_\_\_ was part of the reason Mr. Valarde's and Mr. Rodriguez's residences were shot at. \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ were suspected of sending out Facebook Messenger text messages containing the address of these South Side Sadato associated houses.

Ms. Dahlberg was asked by Mr. Rodriguez if she wanted a tazer to be left in case Ms. Dahlberg needed it against \_\_\_\_\_. Ms. Dahlberg declined the tazer. Ms. Prado then showed up with her son \_\_\_\_\_ and shortly after Ms. Romero, Mr. Rodriguez and Ms. Prado left Ms. Dahlberg's residence.

Ms. Dahlberg estimated that Ms. Romero and Mr. Rodriguez brought \_\_\_\_\_ to her residence at approximately 6:00 am and ran away at approximately 3:00 pm. Ms. Dahlberg then called Ms. Prado's phone and it was answered by Mr. Rodriguez. Ms. Dahlberg told Mr. Rodriguez that \_\_\_\_\_ had run out her back door and she was fast. Mr. Rodriguez told Ms. Dahlberg, "I asked you if you wanted a tazer!"

On Wednesday, March 29, 2017, Detective Andrew Thompson performed an interview with Angelita Prado (DOB 4/13/95), at the OTS. Ms. Prado corroborated the descriptions of the kidnapping provided by Ms. Romero, and by Ms. Dahlberg. Ms. Prado admitted to the following sequence of events:

Ms. Prado drove with Mr. Rodriguez and \_\_\_\_\_ to a gas station. At the gas station Ms. Prado asked for \_\_\_\_\_ cell phone. When \_\_\_\_\_ asked for her phone back, Ms. Prado refused to return it, and stated she was keeping the phone because she liked it. Ms. Prado applied a blindfold to \_\_\_\_\_ before driving her from a gas station to an apartment to pick up Ms. Romero.

Ms. Prado drove with Mr. Rodriguez, Ms. Romero, and \_\_\_\_\_ to the Super 8 Motel, at 605 Peterson Road (where \_\_\_\_\_ described being assaulted and "tazed" by Ms. Romero). After spending time at the motel, \_\_\_\_\_ departed with Mr. Rodriguez and Ms. Romero, and Ms. Prado drove to her house to pick up her seven month old son, \_\_\_\_\_. Ms. Prado then rejoined the others Ms. Dahlberg's apartment, at 2133 Delta Drive, Apartment E. Ms. Prado stated that she left her son in the care of \_\_\_\_\_ while she left with Mr. Rodriguez and Ms. Romero.


Ms. Prado admitted that she was upset with \_\_\_\_\_ for causing Mr. Rodriguez to lose his job from McDonald's, which motivated her aforementioned actions. When Ms. Prado was confronted about the use of a tazer against \_\_\_\_\_ she requested an attorney. The interview was concluded at that time.

Ms. Dahlberg's statements during the interview are consistent with statements made by Ms. Romero and Ms. Prado. Ms. Dahlberg's statements show she had firsthand knowledge of the kidnapping of \_\_\_\_\_ and are consistent with Ms Dahlberg being involved.

I respectfully request an arrest warrant be issued for Ms. Dahlberg, as I believe there is probable cause to believe that **Breeana Eloise Dahlberg, SSN: \_\_\_\_\_ DOB: 09/02/1996, White female, 5'06", 180 lbs, brown hair, blue eyes**, did within the County of El Paso and State of Colorado, committed, in violation of the Colorado Revised Statutes 1973 as amended, the offense(s) of:

**C.R.S. 18-3-302(1)(3)(b)(II) Second Degree Kidnapping, 1 count, a class 3 felony.**

This investigation (along with EPSO Homicide Case \_\_\_\_\_) has revealed a continual pattern of criminal conspiracy to commit kidnapping and murder among a gang associated syndicate of convicted felons. As a result, Your affiant is requesting an elevated bond of \$100,000.00.
