ORDER RE: PRETRIAL PUBLICITY [O-1]	

The Court anticipates the case may receive some attention from the media and has already done so. The case is likely to continue to generate media attention. In order to protect the rights of all parties to a fair trial by an impartial jury as guaranteed by the Colorado and United States Constitutions, and consistent with Rule 3.6 of the Colorado Rules of Professional Conduct, the Court enters the following Order re: Pretrial Publicity:

1. This Order shall apply to all parties, attorneys of record, any attorney associated with an attorney of record, employees of the District Attorney’s Office, employees of any party or attorney of record, investigators working on behalf of any party or attorney of record, and all public law enforcement agencies involved in the investigation of this case.
2. No person identified in paragraph 1 of this Order shall make any extrajudicial statement regarding any aspect of this case, except as follows:
 - a. Information contained in a public record, including information contained in Court documents which have not been filed under seal;
 - b. Information disclosed during Court proceedings unless such proceedings are closed by Court order;
 - c. The fact that an investigation is in progress and a request for information or assistance in connection with that investigation;
 - d. The dates of any scheduled court appearances and the general nature of the matters to be addressed at those hearing, unless such proceedings are closed by Court order;
 - e. Identifying information regarding the accused;
 - f. The fact, time, and place of arrest; and
 - g. The identity of investigating and/or arresting officers and the agency with which they are associated.
3. All attorneys of record are ORDERED to disseminate copies of this Order to all persons associated with their side of this case. Those persons should also be advised of the possible remedies which could be imposed, including contempt or

- change of Venue, for violation of the terms of this Order.
4. The Order shall remain in effect until further Order of this Court.
