**AMENDMENT TO DECORUM ORDER TO ALLOW JOURNALISTS TO UTILIZE ELECTRONIC DEVICES IN THE COURTROOM**

The court has received numerous inquiries about whether journalists will be allowed to utilize electronic devices in the courtroom during the preliminary hearing. This order is intended to amend the previous decorum order which prohibited the use of such devices without a court order.

Journalists are hereby permitted to use electronic devices to report on the case from the courtroom during the preliminary hearing and any future hearing, however such reporting is limited to note taking, emailing, texting or other forms of messaging. No recording, broadcasting, or livestreaming is permitted unless the court has issued an expanded media coverage order for the hearing. This means journalists may use smartphones, tablets and laptop computers in the courtroom as long as such use is discreet. No cameras or audio or video recorders may be used.
