ORDER REQUIRING COUNSEL TO FILE REDACTED VERSIONS OF FILINGS WHICH CONTAIN INFORMATION NOT SUITABLE FOR PUBLIC ACCESS		

Given the high interest in this case by the media and the public, this court is called upon to plan for the media and the public to have access to those portions of the court file which statute and Chief Justice Directive allow. To assist in this regard, Colorado Judicial and the 4th Judicial District have designated this case a Case of Interest, which means that the state judicial and 4th Judicial District websites will contain a link for the public to access filings in this case. Court staff will be posting redacted versions of filings in this matter to such websites, and because the case may contain a large number of filings, court staff will weekly post a register of actions to assist the public in identifying filings of interest.

For these reasons, in addition to editable and non-editable versions of filings already required of counsel, from this date forward, counsel are hereby ordered to also file a redacted version of any filing. Chief Justice directive 05-01, effective January 4, 2022, controls access to court records, and counsel are encouraged to review that directive in full. However, for the purpose of this order, the court directs counsel's attention to Section 4.60(g) which provides:

Section 4.60 - COURT RECORDS EXCLUDED FROM PUBLIC ACCESS

...

(g) Access to pleadings or documents that contain the following information will be provided after appropriate redaction of the information. Unless the information is personal to a party that has signed a release of information that meets the requirements of Addendum E, pleadings or documents requested by a person who possesses such a release are not exempt from the redaction requirements. Requests for protected court records shall be handled administratively and shall not require a court order unless otherwise required by Sections 4.60(b) through (f).

- (1) Data or information restricted by court order in specific cases
- (2) Driver license numbers
- (3) Financial account numbers (This provision does not require redaction when only the last four digits of an account number have been provided to identify an account if it does not reveal the entire account number.)
- (4) Personal identification numbers (e.g., passport, student ID, state ID ("SID"), etc.)
- (5) Pleadings or documents that contain victim identifying information in cases with sex offenses
- (6) Social Security Numbers ("SSN"), including partial SSNs (7) Tax Identification Numbers

WHEREFORE, in addition to the editable and non-editable versions already required, the parties are ordered to file a redacted version of any filing which contains information required to be redacted pursuant to CJD 05-01.
