MOTION TO VACATE COURT DATE		
[D-28]		

Mx. Anderson Aldrich¹, by and through counsel, moves the Court to vacate the currently scheduled April 21, 2023 court date. As grounds they state the following:

FACTS

- 1. On March 30, 2023, Mx. Aldrich requested a court order directing the disclosure of additional materials pursuant to a warrant served on Discord Inc. the defenses' concerns were outlined in [D-27].
- 2. On March 31, 2023, the motion was addressed in part, with the court granting the prosecution leave to respond in writing.
- 3. On April 7, 2023, the prosecution responded by attesting that further information from the warrant was forthcoming, and would be disclosed to the defense by the "end of the month." *See Aldrich Response to D27 demand for discovery of discord records.* It appears based on the prosecution's pleading that there was over ten different discord accounts which were the subject of the search warrants, counsel is assuming this material is voluminous.
- 4. With these additional records on the way, it would be premature to litigate this issue before defense counsel has had time to review the disclosures proposed in the district

attorney's response. Mx. Aldrich is constitutionally entitled to have a defense team effectively investigate their case. U.S. Const. amends. VI, VIII, XIV; Colo. Const. art. II, §§ 16, 20, 25.

- 5. Only after a review of these future disclosures will counsel know whether the assistance of the Court in acquiring further discovery will be necessary. It does not appear that counsel will even have part of, or all of this forthcoming disclosure by the time of the April 21, 2023, court appearance.
- 6. The District Attorneys do not object to vacating the April 21, 2023, appearance.

WHEREFORE, Anderson Aldrich respectfully requests the court vacate the currently scheduled appearance on April 21, 2023, and allow counsel to notice in a future date if necessary, or alternatively, to reset for hearing in May prior to arraignment on May 30, 2023.
