PEOPLE'S RESPONSE TO DEFENDANT'S OBJECTION TO EXPANDED MEDIA COVERAGE	

Comes Now, Michael J. Allen, District Attorney in and for the Fourth Judicial District, County of El Paso, State of Colorado, by and through his duly appointed Chief Deputy District Attorneys, respectfully submits this Response to Defendant's Objection to Expanded Media Coverage.

1. The People concur with the Defendants Motion to the extent that it reports not receiving notice of the requests for expanded coverage – only the denied orders are visible to the People.
2. The People concur as to applicability of Colorado Rule of Public Access and Information 3, but of course, the full text of the rule provides far more governing detail than just the three part test listed in the Defense Objection. The People defer to the Court as to its determination of the respective rights determination, except to note that the notion of unfettered access to custodial photos belies the obvious inherent power of the Court to define access and use as specifically provided for in the rule above.
