Pikes Peak Library District and the Fourth Judicial District are working in conjunction to provide free access to virtual courtrooms.

This service is only for the El Paso County Combined Courts. It does not provide access to Federal Court, Municipal Court, Social Security Administrative Hearings, or any other administrative hearing.

Virtual courtrooms can be accessed via library laptops at the following locations:

Reservations must be made at least one week before your court date and are subject to library approval.

To check out a laptop to access the virtual courtroom, you will need a valid library card. To apply for a free library card, you will need an ID and proof of address. You can apply for a low barrier card without proof of address.
