Eviction Diversion Mediation Program El Paso County



Free mediation services between tenants and landlords with conflicts involving non-payment of rent, alleged lease violations, and security deposits.

What is Mediation?

Mediation uses trained, neutral third parties who help the parties talk to each other and find a mutually beneficial solution. The mediation is held remotely, and each party can choose to attend by video conference or phone. Mediation usually takes place within a week of the written request to participate in this program.

Why Mediate?



Save time and money. Mediation is free and can be scheduled faster than a court hearing.



Produce a creative solution. Craft an agreement to meet your needs.



Less Stressful. You have control over the outcome in a more informal environment.



Remain confidential. Unlike court procedures, mediation communications are confidential.
