

PRESIDING JUVENILE JUDGE ORDER 2015-1

RE: PRESIDING JUVENILE JUDGE ORDER REGARDING NAMING OF FOSTER PARENT INTERVENORS

Effective on the date of this order, all foster parents who are approved as intervenors before the court in dependency and neglect proceedings shall no longer have their initials used as identifiers in the pleadings or in courtroom proceedings. The foster parents' full names shall be listed on the case caption and all pleadings, and will be utilized in courtroom proceedings.

For all existing cases before the court in which foster parents have already intervened as parties and whose initials are currently being utilized, counsel may raise the issue and request a ruling from the court based upon the individual circumstances of the case.
