



Colorado State Rules and Regulations now require all children in childcare settings to provide an immunization record.

Court Care continues to implement this policy, allowing parents who did not have record of their child's immunizations the opportunity to sign a waiver of vaccinations.

Effective August 1, 2021, the rules have changed, and this waiver is no longer an option. Parents will have the option to sign a vaccination plan on the first visit if they do not have the record of vaccinations. If the family returns, they will need to bring in the immunization record. This will apply to those attending court, including jurors, court attendees, and witnesses. This will also apply to those who are attending probation meetings or other court-mandated appearances.

If a parent declines to comply with this requirement, Court Care will ask them to leave until the immunization record is brought in. This requirement is in compliance with our regulations for licensure.
