



The District Attorney, by and through his Chief Deputy District Attorney, Jeffrey D. Lindsey, hereby informs the Court that the parties have agreed to release certain property items as listed below.

1. CSPD "Bearcat", Colorado govt. license plate: \_\_\_\_\_, 2011 Ford truck chassis, \_\_\_\_\_ Tactical Rescue Vehicle by LENCO.
2. EPSO "Bear" Colorado govt. license plate: \_\_\_\_\_, 2005 Freightliner chassis, \_\_\_\_\_ Tactical rescue vehicle by LENCO.
3. All evidence related to the investigation and tied to the vehicles has been collected for evidentiary purposes. The vehicles have been extensively photographed and swabbed where biological material was found.
4. Both vehicles were inspected at the Colorado Springs Police Department, Police Operations Center by the Public Defender's Office attorneys and their investigator on December 4, 2015. After the inspection the Public Defender's Office agreed to stipulate to the release of the above mentioned vehicles.
5. The vehicles are necessary for both agencies in their continued service to their communities.

**WHEREFORE**, the District Attorney respectfully requests this Court approve the stipulation.
