



<b>STIPULATION TO RELEASE TACTICAL POLICE GEAR COLLECTED DURING THE INVESTIGATION</b>	

The District Attorney, by and through his Chief Deputy District Attorney, Jeffrey D. Lindsey, hereby informs the Court that the parties have agreed to release certain property items as listed below.

1. During the shooting at the Planned Parenthood on November 27, 2015, numerous police officers from both the Colorado Springs Police Department (CSPD) and the El Paso County Sheriff's Office (EPSO) deployed police gear to assist them in the efforts to apprehend the suspect, Robert Dear, Jr.
2. Much of the gear is necessary for continued operations of both CSPD and EPSO. During the processing of the scene, the vehicles and the officers gear was inspected, documented and photographed by investigators from the Colorado Springs Metro Crime Lab and the Colorado Bureau of Investigations.
3. The crime scene investigators have indicated that any of the gear that was impacted or had evidence on it was retained and placed in evidence at the Metro Crime Laboratory. Pursuant to an agreement and discussions that occurred on the record in open court on December 9, 2015, the remaining gear that was not determined to be evidentiary is to be released back to the appropriate agency. The gear that is to be released will be the subject of a police report which will be provided to the defense through normal discovery.

WHEREFORE, the District Attorney respectfully requests this Court approve the stipulation
