Whereas the application is in proper form and probable cause is found for the issuance of a Search Warrant to search the person(s) and or premises specified in the application.

THEREFORE, the applicant, and any other peace officer into whose hands this Search Warrant shall come, is hereby ordered, with the necessary and proper assistance, to enter and search within the next fourteen (14) days the person, premises, location and any appurtenances thereto, description of which is:

The person of Robert Lewis Dear Jr., DOB: 04/16/1958. He is a white male, approximately 6'2", 250 pounds.

The following person(s), property or thing(s) will be searched for and if found seized:

See Attachment 'B' which is hereby incorporated in reference

as probable cause has been found to believe that it:

- Is stolen or embezzled, or
- Is designed or intended for use in committing a criminal offense, or
- Is or has been used as a means of committing a criminal offense, or
- Is illegal to possess, or
- Would be material evidence in a subsequent criminal prosecution, or required, authorized or permitted by a statute of the State of Colorado, or
- Is a person, property or thing the seizure of which is expressly required, authorized or permitted by a statute of the State of Colorado, or
- Is kept, stored, transported, sold, dispensed, or possessed in violation of a statute of the State of Colorado under circumstances involving a serious threat to the public safety, or order, or to the public health, or
- That would aid in the detection of the whereabouts of or in the apprehension of a person for whom a lawful arrest order is outstanding.

Furthermore, a copy of this warrant is to be left with the person whose premises or person is searched along with a list of any and all items seized at the time of its execution. If said person cannot be located or identified, a copy of the search Warrant and the list of property seized shall be left at the place from which the property was taken.

Further, a return shall be promptly made to this Court upon the execution of this Search Warrant along with an inventory of any property taken. The property seized shall be held in some safe place until the Court shall further order.

In support of a request for the issuance of a Search Warrant to search the location described as The person of Robert Lewis Dear Jr., DOB: 04/16/1958. He is a white male, approximately 6'2", 250 pounds.; your affiant, Detective J. Schiffelbein | 3343, a Police Officer for the Colorado Springs Police Department and so employed for over 8 years and now currently assigned to the Violent Crimes-Homicide Unit, state under oath that I have personal knowledge of the following facts:

On November 27, 2015, at approximately 11:30 a.m., The Colorado Springs Police Department (CSPD), and University of Colorado at Colorado Springs Police Department (UCCS) responded to a report of an active shooter at the Planned Parenthood located at 3480 Centennial Blvd in Colorado Springs, Colorado. Initial reports of multiple shots, reported as over twenty, being fired from an automatic weapon were received. Initial reports indicated at least one victim was shot. CSPD Officers and UCCS Officer responded and arrived on scene and immediately came under fire.

3480 Centennial Blvd. is located within the City of Colorado Springs, County of El Paso, State of Colorado.

Information related to the suspect described him as an older white male with facial hair standing near a truck in the parking lot of Planned Parenthood. The suspect was reported as shooting a long gun. The suspect was reported as walking into Planned Parenthood firing shots. Initial reports from responding officers included two people shot and medical response was requested. Officers reported active shooting continued and officers were being fired upon. This included responding police patrol cars.

Witnesses at the scene reported seeing a male suspect enter the Planned Parenthood building carrying black bags over his shoulder.

During the active shooter and response by the Colorado Springs Police Department, El Paso County Sheriff's Office, University of Colorado at Colorado Springs Police Department, multiple officers were shot and sustained injuries. Officer [REDACTED] of the Colorado Springs Police Department was shot in the left hand. Officer [REDACTED] with the Colorado Springs Police Department Tactical Enforcement Unit was shot in the left leg. Officer [REDACTED] with the Colorado Springs Police Department Tactical Enforcement Unit sustained a gunshot wound to the left hand and left upper arm area. Officer [REDACTED] with the Colorado Springs Police Department sustained a gunshot wound to the upper left arm. Sergeant [REDACTED] with the El Paso County Sheriff's Department sustained a gunshot wound to the right lower leg.

Officer [REDACTED] with the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs Police Department was also shot, and he succumbed to his injuries at the scene. It is currently unknown how many times Officer [REDACTED] was shot or the location of his gunshot wounds.

During the course of the active shooter situation, tactical officers reported that the suspect had shot at propane tanks that he had outside of the building next to a vehicle.

Information regarding a Mr. W [REDACTED] [REDACTED] 02/17/183 was received that he was in the parking lot with his girlfriend, S [REDACTED] W [REDACTED] 11/02/78, and a friend named [REDACTED]. He reported as he was exiting his vehicle in the parking lot he was shot two times as he attempted to flee. He further reported that he believed [REDACTED] had also been shot and was deceased on scene. He stated Ms. W [REDACTED] was also shot and wounded.

S [REDACTED] W [REDACTED] was interviewed by Detective Schiffelbein, and she advised that as she was in the parking lot of Planned Parenthood, an older white male approached her. She advised that the male told her she shouldn't have come here today and then shot her multiple times, striking her in the right upper arm.

There are other victims also associated with this incident, but this information is still being learned and the investigation is still on-going. It is believed that in addition to Officer [REDACTED] there is at least one other deceased victim.

Robert Lewis Dear, DOB: 04/16/1958, was contacted by Tactical Officers within the Planned Parenthood Building after he had indicated he was going to surrender. As Robert Lewis Dear was being placed into a patrol car, he yelled out a statement about the killing of babies.

Robert Lewis Dear was interviewed by Detective J. Schiffelbein with the Colorado Springs Police Department and Detective S. Mackey with the El Paso County Sheriff's Department. During this interview, Robert Lewis Dear told Detectives that he had gone to the Planned Parenthood location because he was upset with them performing abortions and the selling of baby parts. Robert Lewis Dear stated he entered the building with 4 SKS rifles, after shooting somebody in the parking lot, and also shooting at a car in the parking lot as well.

Robert Lewis Dear continued on by saying that while inside of the building, he saw a police officer approaching a window with a gun, and because the tint on the window the officer could not see him (Lewis). Robert Lewis Dear advised he knew this person was a police officer because of the uniform he was wearing and shot him through the window. Based on the information provided by Robert Lewis Dear, it is believed that this officer is Officer [REDACTED].


Robert Lewis Dear advised he also shot at other officers as they arrived on scene, and stated he had placed the propane tanks outside and planned on shooting them to make them explode. Robert Lewis Dear stated he did shoot the propane tanks during the course of the shooting incident, but they did not explode.

Robert Lewis Dear had an injury to his right hand, and also had an injury to his lower abdomen which he said was from being shot by officers. Robert Lewis Dear stated he was wearing a homemade ballistic vest during the course of this shooting.

Because of the dynamics of the shooting, as well as the anticipated testing of items of evidence collected as part of this investigation, a DNA standard needs to be obtained from Robert Lewis for comparison purposes as part of this DNA testing. Additionally, fingerprints are needed to assist in direct comparisons of any items of evidence collected at the scene or other locations as the investigation continues.



Roche, registration number 44140, respectfully request this Court enter an Order, sealing the Search Warrant and Application, to include the Affidavit and Attachment "A" and/or "B", and any other document associated with the search warrant as grounds, therefore states the following:

1. The Criminal Case Report supporting this Search Warrant was initiated by the Colorado Springs Police Department (CSPD), PD case number 15-47334, and the El Paso County Sheriff (EPSO), SO case number 15-16087, is an ongoing homicide and burglary investigation.
