<b>[P-38]</b>  <b>NOTICE OF PEOPLE'S INTENT TO INTRODUCE SELF-AUTHENTICATING RECORDS AT TRIAL PURSUANT TO C.R.S. 902 (11) – VERIZON</b>	

Comes now, Michael J. Allen, District Attorney for the Fourth Judicial District, by and through his duly appointed Deputy District Attorney, respectfully submits the following, [P-38] Notice of People's Intent to Introduce Self-Authenticating Records at Trial Pursuant to C.R.S. 902(11) – Verizon. In support thereof, the People state:

1. Pursuant to Colo. Evid. Rule 902(11), a party must give notice to the other parties if they intend to use self-authenticating business records and must make the records and affidavit available for inspection sufficiently in advance of the offer into evidence to provide the adverse party an opportunity to challenge them.
2. C.R.E. 902(11) provides that certified business records are self-authenticating documents provided they are accompanied by an affidavit of their custodian certifying the records were (a) made at or near the time of the occurrence of the matters set forth by or from information transmitted by a person with knowledge of those matters, (b) were kept in the course of regularly conducted activity, and (c) were made by the regularly conducted activity as a regular practice.
3. Attached is the copy of the affidavit the People intend to introduce at trial: Verizon records for Target Number: 407-375-3463. (*People's Attachment A*)
4. The People intend to introduce these records using the Rule of Evidence as opposed to calling the Custodian of Records from Verizon.
