<b>D-19</b> <b>MOTION TO AUTHORIZE 30 HOURS FOR THE SECOND COMPETENCY</b> <b>EVALUATION</b>	

Counsel requests that this Court authorize Dr. Jackie Grimmert to use 30 hours, rather than the standard 10 hours, to complete the second competency evaluation of Ms. Stauch. Dr. Grimmert has contacted defense counsel to request more time to conduct her evaluation. Dr. Grimmert cited the extraordinary amount of discovery in this case as the reason for needing additional hours.

Pursuant to the Supreme Court of Colorado Chief Justice Directive 12-03, mental health professionals conducting competency evaluations may be paid a reasonable amount to not exceed \$150 per hour for a maximum of ten hours. In addition, the competency evaluator may be compensated for travel time at a rate of 50% of the authorized hourly rate, not to exceed six hours.

In this case, based on the nature of discovery, Dr. Grimmatt requires more than the standard 10 hours – and requests that this court authorize 30 hours.
