

ATTACHMENT "A"

Your Affiant is Detective Rosario S. Hubbell, a duly sworn peace officer in the County of El Paso, State of Colorado. Your Affiant is employed by the El Paso County Sheriff's Office and is currently assigned to the Investigations Division.

Your Affiant was so employed on Wednesday December 30, 2015 when your affiant was requested to respond to the Office of the Sheriff to assist with an officer involved shooting by the Colorado Springs Police Department (CSPD). Your affiant was briefed and learned the following.

CSPD Officers Terria Crocket and Michael Garnett responded to a burglary in progress call at Sierra Springs Drive, in Colorado Springs, Colorado. Officer Garnett stops his vehicle just past the address of occurrence and is in front of the house just to the south. Officer Crocket stops her vehicle just prior to the address of occurrence at the house just to the north.

Officer Garnett got out of his vehicle and immediately heard gun shots. He saw a muzzle flash and estimated the direction of the muzzle flash to be directly towards Officer Crocket. He does not have a clear shot at the suspect and does not return fire. The suspect then got into a dark colored Chevy sedan and drove between both marked police cars fleeing the scene.

Witness _____ who resides at _____ Sierra Park _____ told Detectives that prior to police arriving at _____ Sierra Springs a white male approximately 25 to 30 years old wearing a dark colored hoodie, with the hood up, was in the drive way of _____ Sierra Spring Drive.

He yelled towards _____ who was standing in his drive way, "Hey you going to help me?" _____ responded to the white male, "Huh?" The white male mumbled something and moved out of sight. _____ entered his home and shortly after heard two gunshots. He then exited his home and saw police pursue a vehicle toward Academy Boulevard.

Witness _____ resides at _____ Sierra Springs Drive, She was on her porch when she saw an unknown white male talking to another neighbor in the drive way of _____ Sierra Springs Drive.

There was a dark colored sedan in the driveway. The neighbor left and the unknown white male went to the garage door of _____ Sierra Springs Drive, grabbed the handle and attempted to lift the garage door. _____ continued to watch the individual for a moment and then she saw the police arrive. She then hears a statement similar to "You shouldn't have done that bitch!" then hears gun shots and goes inside her residence.

Witness _____ who resides at _____ Sierra Springs Drive, is contacted by Detectives and he has video surveillance. The video is viewed and an individual can be seen standing in the driveway of _____ Sierra Springs Drive talking to another person walking two dogs.

The person walking the dogs leaves and CSPD vehicles arrive. An officer exit her vehicle and the individual in the driveway shoots at CSPD by pointing his firearm in a north east direction. The CSPD officer returns fire pointing her firearm in a southwest direction. A dark sedan pulls out of the driveway and CSPD pursues the vehicle.

Witness _____ who resides at _____ Sierra Springs Drive _____ confirmed he heard two gunshots and saw police officers pursue a vehicle away from _____ Sierra Springs Drive.

also stated that he spoke with the potential suspect shortly before he heard the shots. went outside to walk his dogs when he observed a blue Chevy sedan parked in the driveway of Sierra Springs Drive. said the vehicle stuck out because of how it was parked. said the vehicle was parked front first in the driveway with the rear blocking some of the side walk.

said he then spoke with the male subject sitting in the car because the male rolled down the window of the car and asked him a question as to whether he knew if the homeowners were home or not. told the male he was unsure and thought it was odd. The male subject told that he was there to drop off a car and needed to find the homeowners. relayed that he was not sure and went back inside his home.

described the male driving the blue Chevy sedan as a white male approximately 5'08 or taller with a goatee, with a hooded jacket and khaki pants.

A short time later, went back outside to see what the male was doing at which time he observed that the blue Chevy sedan was now parked backwards into the driveway. noted that this was suspicious so he began to watch a little closer as to what the male was doing. The unknown male then approached again, in an effort to find the homeowners.

The male told that he knocked on the door and had lost his key to the garage. said the garage doors in their neighborhood do not have a key access, they only have a pin pad to gain access into the garage.

During this time observed the male try to lift the garage door, but it was locked and he was not able to get inside. went back inside his home and told his girlfriend to be prepared to call 911 because something was wrong.

As walked inside the door he then heard two gunshots. He looked outside and saw two Colorado Springs Police cars in the roadway with their emergency lights activated. The blue Chevy sedan was now pulling out of the driveway and the police pursued.

was not sure who fired the gun, but believed the unknown male had a gun. described the subject as nervous and having "A.D.D." When the male was talking to the subject positioned his hands on his front waistband like he had a gun. stated he never saw a firearm, just the actions the subject was making.

Witness the victim, told detectives at approximately 2100 hours she was in bed inside her residence, located at Sierra Springs Dr. in Colorado Springs, Colorado, when she heard loud banging noises coming from her garage.

She looked out her bedroom window, which is located on the second story of the home directly above the garage, and observed a dark colored four door sedan parked in her driveway. The vehicle was parked so close to her garage door, she could not see its front end from her window.

She also saw a dark figure moving around toward the garage door and then she heard banging again. She flipped on her bedroom light hoping whoever it was would realize someone was home and would leave. This did not work and the banging got worse.

After hearing the banging and seeing the vehicle in her driveway, went to grab a handgun, but didn't know how to load it, so she called her husband, to see what she should do.

_____ was recently hired by _____ and is staying at a friend's house in the Denver Metro area on the days he works and returning home on days off. _____ advised _____ not to mess with the gun and to just call 911.

After hanging up with her husband, and before calling 911, _____ first called a neighbor to see if he could come over and scare off whoever was parked in the driveway. She was unable to reach the neighbor and subsequently called 911.

While on the phone with the 911 operator, _____ was asked to again look outside to see if the car was still there or if she could see anyone. When she looked out the window for the second time, she could still see the car in her driveway and now saw a male party standing in the front yard.

While awaiting the arrival of police, _____ stayed on the phone with the 911 operator, but realized her phone was dying, so she bent down to grab a charger to plug in her phone. As soon as she bent down to grab the charger, _____ heard two gunshots.

_____ relayed this information to the 911 operator and was directed to lock herself in a room. _____ went and grabbed her two year old son from his room and took him to her three year old daughter's room where she barricaded the door. _____ then began communicating with neighbors through her daughter's bedroom window.

_____ asked the 911 operator if the police were on their way and was informed Officers had located, and were now in pursuit with, the vehicle that had been parked in her driveway. After learning the suspect was no longer on scene, _____ went downstairs and let one of her neighbors in through a back door. This neighbor then stayed with her until police arrived.

CSPD pursued the blue Chevy to the area of Whittier Drive and Ruskin Drive where CSPD officer Brandon McCoy performs a tactical vehicle intervention (TVI) stopping the blue Chevy. The male driving the vehicle is identified as Thomas James Goulee DOB: 11/11/81.

Mr. Goulee is searched and has a Smith & Wesson model 65 shot revolver recovered from the pocket of the sweat pants he was wearing. The vehicle, a blue Chevy, vin # _____ is run and found to be stolen.

A criminal history query was completed for Mr. Goulee. This query revealed guilty rulings for the following criminal offenses:

May 15, 2000 Felony Menacing

November 8, 2000 Possession of a weapon by previous offender, and Possession of Dangerous Drugs (Schedule II)

May 14, 2007 Violent Crime- Causing Death or Serious Bodily Injury, and Obstructing Justice witness or victim intimidation

Mr. Goulee also has multiple convictions for felony parole violations.

Based on his criminal history and the seriousness of the new charges your affiant believes Mr. Goulee to be a serious flight risk and requests an increased bond.

Therefore, based on the above described facts and circumstances, Your Affiant respectfully moves this Honorable Court for issuance of an arrest warrant naming **Thomas James Goulee, W/M, DOB: 11/11/1981, Height 5'9", Weight 160 lbs, Bln hair, Blu eyes,** defendant for the crime(s) of:

C.R.S. 18-2-101. Criminal attempt, 18-3-107 First degree murder of a peace officer, a class 2 felony.
