<b>DECORUM ORDER</b>	

The following Decorum Order will be posted on the doors outside Courtroom for Division 11 and throughout the Teller County Courthouse.

### **SPECTATORS MUST OBSERVE PROPER COURTHOUSE DECORUM**

Pursuant to Order:

- Audible comments and emotional displays or outbursts, as well as the display of insignias, symbols, pictures, clothing, or any other items that may influence the jury or which are an issue or cause are strictly prohibited.
- If at any time during the proceedings you feel the onset of an emotional reaction that may violate the Court's Order, please quietly and discreetly exit the courtroom.
- The courthouse was built in 1904 and has two very small hallways on each floor. Both courts are expected to be in session on February 19<sup>th</sup>. The Teller County Clerk and Recorder, Treasurer and Assessor's offices are also located in the courthouse.

In order to protect the privacy of all persons using the courthouse, no audio or video recording devices, cameras or any photographic devices including cell phone cameras, or ipads may be used at any time for recording, or photographs inside the entire courthouse or courtrooms on February 19, 2019 without prior approval of this Court. Use of such items may result in its confiscation and the initiation of contempt proceedings against the user which could result in the imposition of a jail sentence.

- Any violation of this Order will be subject to contempt proceedings and sanctions, and may be barred from the hearing.
