


Administrative Order No. 2020-4

Due to the COVID-19 epidemic and the concurrent necessity to limit jail population, Amended Administrative Order 2018-7 states the order goes into effect when the jail population reaches 200. As conditions change, the order is further amended such that at the discretion of the LPCJ Commander, the order may be implemented when the inmate population reaches 180 inmates. The Chief Judge shall be notified within 24 hours upon the lowering of this initiating threshold and given the reasons the initiating threshold was lowered. Regardless of which initiating threshold is in effect, the population reduction measures goes out of effect when the jail population reaches 160 inmates. This amendment shall remain in effect for so long as Administrative Order 2020-3 remains in effect.
