



<b>ADDITIONAL ORDER REGARDING THE PRETRIAL CONFERENCE (C-43)</b>	

At the PTC held on 3/6/20, defense counsel concerned that exhibits that are going to be used by the prosecution may not contain “proper redactions.” Defense counsel requested the Court order some sort of expedited process so the exhibits can be reviewed by defense counsel to ensure inadmissible material is not contained in evidence that will be presented to the jury. If the Court’s memory is correct, it reviewed approximately 60 hours of audio and video recordings of the defendant. The Court issued orders regarding the admissibility of these statements on January 17, 2019. Having had this order for over a year, it appears somewhat dilatory for the defense to bring this issue to the Court’s attention less than one month before trial. However, a **quick** review of the Court’s January 17, 2019 order reveals that the Court precluded **Redacted**, that it precluded the entire interview of the defendant by Larry Backer that occurred on November 21, 2012 and ordered that those portions of the interview of the defendant by Deputy Cowing and Special Agent Cowing on February 24, 2014 that discussed allegations of domestic violence in the defendant’s first marriage be deleted. The Court would suggest, but does not order, that the parties cross check the transcripts of these statements against

the prosecution's exhibits to ensure that the Court's orders have been followed. If there are violations of the Court's orders on these three topics, or if evidence is admitted in violation of any other of the Court's orders, the offending party runs the risk of being sanctioned.
