

<b>Order Regarding the Disclosure of Dr. Ha's Expert Opinions</b>	

At the status conference held on October 16, 2020, a dispute arose as to whether the defense had properly disclosed defense expert Dr. James Ha's opinions and the basis of those opinions. The prosecution objected to the Court allowing Dr. Ha to testify in this case. The defense has not provided the prosecution with a report of Dr. Ha's opinions or the basis of those opinions in compliance with C. R. Crim. P. 16 II (b) as previously ordered by this Court. However, the defense did arrange for Dr. Ha to be interviewed by the prosecution and a report of that interview was made and marked as discovery. While the bases of his opinions are somewhat generic, the Court finds that if Dr. Ha is properly qualified as an expert during the trial, he will be allowed to testify concerning the information contained in Investigator Heidel's report that was marked as pp 24,447 - 24,454 of discovery. He will not be allowed to give more detailed testimony than what is contained in Investigator Heidel's report or in any previously filed expert disclosure. Dr. Ha will not be allowed to testify as to any new opinions he may have formed after the date of Investigator Heidel's report unless it has been appropriately disclosed.
