



Order Declaring Mistrial, Resetting the Trial, Continuing Previously Served Subpoenas and Recalculating of Speedy Trial (C-51)	

A setting Conference was held on June 23, 2020. At that time, the Court found that due to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court's extension of the state-wide moratorium on jury trials to protect the health of the public, and the inability to seek a waiver from the moratorium based upon the complexity and length of this particular trial, the Court finds pursuant to C. R. Crim. P. 24(c)(4), that a public health crisis prevents the Court from safely assembling a fair jury pool and declares a mistrial in this case.

This case is reset for a 6-week jury trial to begin on October 28, 2020 at 8:00 AM with an all-day PTC set for October 8 at 9:00 AM. All subpoenas previously issued and served upon witnesses are continued until October 28, 2020.

The Court further finds that prior to the declaration of a mistrial, the statutory speedy trial time period expired on October 31, 2020. With the 113-day delay cause by the mistrial, an additional 3 months is added to speedy trial calculations extending the expiration of speedy trial to January 30, 2021. See CRS 18-1-405 (6) (e). If either side disagrees with this calculation, they shall notify the Court within 21 days.
