



Order: TO STRIKE DURANGO HERALDS LETTER AND DEMAND FOR ORDER PROHIBITING THE UNAUTHORIZED PRACTICE OF LAW [D-0]	

The motion/proposed order attached hereto: DENIED.

Defense counsel has filed a motion under seal without citing a statute authorizing it to do so, or obtaining an order from the Court allowing the motion to be filed under seal. The Court has read the motion and orders that the motion and this order be filed such that it is open to the public. The Court further orders that while the defendant may file properly redacted motions for the public access file in this case, unless authorized by statute, rule of the Court or Court order, the defendant may not file motions in this case under seal or file any motion as suppressed.

The defendant is correct that the Durango Herald attempted to file a letter in this case requesting expanded media coverage. The letter was rejected and not accepted for filing. Mr. Benjamin was instructed to follow the new procedure instituted by the State Court Administrator's Office by filing his request online. The Court ensured that both the District Attorney's Office and the Public Defender's office received the request, even though the Public Defender's office could not yet enter an appearance as the defendant was not yet in custody in La Plata County. The Durango Herald complied with Rule 3, Chapter 38 of the Supreme Court Rules regarding requests for expanded media coverage. The Court does not find that Mr. Benjamin has engaged in the unauthorized practice of law and denies this motion in its entirety.
