
For the reasons stated on the record at the pretrial conference on 3/5/20, the Court is concerned that outside groups may try to influence the jury during the course of the trial. The Court orders that the jury that is empaneled in this case shall [REDACTED].
 [REDACTED]. The bailiffs will meet the jurors at the reserved parking lots and accompany the jury [REDACTED] to and from the courthouse. Jurors will be returned to their vehicles when the trial ends each day.

Deputies will [REDACTED] transport the jury. The drivers shall be dressed in plain clothes and any weapons on their person shall be concealed. The drivers are not to talk to the jurors about any aspect of the case until after a verdict has been returned in court. [REDACTED].

Mr. Redwine shall be transported to and from the La Plata County Jail [REDACTED]. He shall be loaded and unloaded at the jail [REDACTED], unseen by the public. [REDACTED]. Mr. Redwine shall arrive at the La Plata County Courthouse [REDACTED]. Mr. Redwine shall be unloaded and loaded into his transport vehicle only [REDACTED] the La Plata County Courthouse [REDACTED] so that he cannot be seen by the public.

Everyone entering the division 4 courtroom from the public hallway shall be subject to a secondary security screening.
