

<b>Order Regarding the Defendants Sixth Addendum to the Motion for a Change of Venue D-186</b>	

The defense has filed D-186 again requesting the Court change venue in this case due to pre-trial publicity. The Court has repeatedly denied the motion without prejudice. The Court notes that prior to a mistrial being declared in this case in November of 2020 due to COVID-19 concerns, the Court and parties had already completed individual voir dire of the venire during which the sensational nature of this case as well as pretrial publicity were extensively investigated by the parties. The Court had sufficient jurors remaining after individual voir dire was completed to believe that a jury could be selected that was not tainted by the pretrial publicity this case has generated. While the proceedings in October and November of 2020, did generate additional publicity, the Court does not find that the additional publicity has been so pervasive as to prohibit a fair and unbiased jury from being selected in this case. For these reasons, and the reasons the Court has previously stated in previous orders, the Court denies the motion without prejudice. If it becomes clear during jury selection in this case that a fair and unbiased jury cannot be selected in this case, either party may again move for a change of venue.
