



<b>Supplemental Order Regarding Alternative Suspects (D-126)</b>	

In the Court's original order as to whether the defense will be allowed to introduce evidence regarding alternative suspects, the Court found that it did not have a sufficient offer of proof as to whether the Court would allow Kallen Elkins to testify concerning proposed alternative suspect Kent Wilson. The Court delayed ruling upon Ms. Elkins' proposed evidence until additional offers of proof were submitted to the Court. Order Regarding the Defendant's Motion in Limine to Introduce Evidence of an Alternative Suspect (D-126), pp. 3, 12.

The prosecution has now filed additional offers of proof showing that the statements attributed to Ms. Elkins were actually the statements of Starla Johnson and James Adcock. See Exhibits 1, 2, and 3 to the People's Notice of Clarification for the Court Regarding Kallen Elkins (P-37). No additional offers of proof regarding Ms. Elkins were submitted by the defense. In the Court's Order Regarding the Defendant's Motion in Limine to Introduce Evidence of an Alternative Suspect (D-126), the Court ruled that neither James Adcock nor Starla Johnson would be allowed to present alternative suspect evidence. Considering the statements were improperly attributed to Kallen Elkins does not change the Court's analysis as to whether to allow Mr. Adcock or Ms. Johnson to testify, as the statements are simply a slightly different recollection of the same statements previously analyzed.

For the foregoing reasons, Ms. Elkins will not be allowed to testify regarding Kent Wilson as a possible alternative suspect in this case and the Court's previous orders regarding James Adcock and Starla Johnson remain as previously ordered.
