

Requirements and Timeline

Unless an agreement resolving all issues regarding the Allocation of Parental Responsibilities (Custody) is filed prior to the setting for Permanent Orders, all parties with children less than 18 years of age must attend and complete a 10th Judicial District approved parenting education class and view the Split video before the Permanent Orders hearing. A request to complete a different parenting education class will be determined upon request. Proof of completion of the parenting education class must be filed with the court prior to the Permanent Orders hearing to avoid sanctions being imposed.
