



# Notice Regarding COVID-19 (Novel Coronavirus) and Court Operations:

The Courts and Probation Department provide important and essential services to the public and we will endeavor to maintain normal operations to the fullest extent possible.

We understand there is concern about COVID-19 and the 10<sup>th</sup> Judicial District is requesting **PLEASE DO NOT COME TO THE COURTHOUSE, PROBATION OR PRETRIAL SERVICES** if:

- You have been **diagnosed** with COVID-19 and you have not received a subsequent test confirming you are currently virus-free;
- You have been **in direct contact** with someone who has been diagnosed with the past 14 days or traveled to a high-risk area within 14 days;
- You are **experiencing symptoms** such as fever, cough, shortness of breath, or any other respiratory illness symptoms.

If any of these three criteria apply, call:

for direction in what to do in your specific case.

**If you are represented by an attorney**, contact your attorney first and they will request the continuance on your behalf.

**If you are subpoenaed as a witness** *in a case, please contact the attorney or party issuing the subpoena.*

*Until further notice, the court will permit surgical masks, gloves and small, plastic bottles of hand sanitizer, if you desire.*
