PROCEDURES REGARDING LIVESTREAMING PURSUANT TO C.R.S. §13-1-132(3.5)

This admirative order puts all parties on notice that in Division 501 pursuant C.R.S. §13-1-132(3.5) all criminal proceedings conducted in open court will be live streamed (absent proceedings excepted in C.R.S. §13-1-132(3.5)(a)(I-IV)) through the Colorado Courts website at https://live.coloradojudicial.gov.

A party, witness, or victim may request that a proceeding not be live streamed. All counsel is put on notice that any request for a proceeding to not be live streamed must be made at least (14) days prior to the hearing in a written motion.

All parties are put on notice there shall be no audio or visual recording, including photography or screenshots of the proceedings, without explicit permission of the court.

All counsel is put on notice there are microphones on each of counsel's table, the witness stand, the bench, and the podium. Counsel is made aware of the placement of these microphones to assure confidential communications and privileged communications in the courtroom. The microphones on counsel's tables can be muted by pushing the button on them.

Any time the Court issues a sequestration order pursuant to C.R.E. 615 counsel shall inform all of his/her witnesses that he/she may not watch any part of the proceedings on the live stream.
