10/6/21 - Tonny Grussin - asked if she could

LR17 - dated 12/23/20 - relayed YSTR
 results on samples - could not compare
 due to both having mixtures

Discussed Auto results of 24.1 & 27.1
 and reasons why 24.1 not in CODIS

Item 9.1 submitted to CODIS back in June

Compared 9.1 to 27.1 - Yes, not same male

Why entered 27.1 when she did - Yes, rules about where profile came from?

Attributed to the putative perp? Attributable to the crime? At the time, didn't have adequate info so didn't add to CODIS & then had subsequent documentation

10/6/2020 - ☎ Joe Cahill were believed to be connected to crime → at that time she was able to  enter into CODIS at that time

That communication was on phone ☎ notes? She asked if CR followed up ☎ Cahill after entry

10/7 - Robin B, Chris Adam, T. Cahill & D. Graham to let them know profiles entered but not notifications

- asked if CR gets notifications herself? Messages in CODIS itself but she is not a CODIS Admin - she doesn't deal with matches on backend; typically gets cc'd on the letters

5/19/2021 → CODIS letter → referred to NED with who was on that email

- When was the 1st conversation CR had on case? 7/1/20 → provide verbal release of results; 7/6/20 → provide VSTRs results
- Verbal release is usually released in RUSTT results
- Was Cahill primary? Documented contacts R. Burgess, C. Adams, J. Cahill, J. Grossing D. Graham
- This week - had a # of phone calls this week 10/25 - D. Graham re: her results Same day - phone conversation to discuss Item 27.1 - reiterated partial CODIS matches to 3 cases - we do not have names unsolved in CODIS
 - 10/25/21 - MED-read note - Agent Graham asked for hit letter copy for meeting
 - 10/27/21 - D. Graham & K. Harris → adding 15 items to be submitted 10/21 hearing
 - 10/27/21 - D. Graham - spoke in person & contact Burgess to get ? answered; asked about additional stds be submitted
 - 10/28/21 - Agent Cahill → documented the email chain for the CODIS hits
- CR entered profile into CODIS and where her role ends; have you talked to anyone

about the strength or weaknesses of the CODIS search

12/2/20 - J. Cahill - a detective from Tempe PD & R. Burgess → keyboard search and wanted to know what it was, partial → may be consistent by chance & a follow up

Doesn't recall if she looked @ those.

Did anyone ask her her opinion?

"Match" comes from CODIS NDIS procedures
any association through CODIS is an investigative lead for them to follow up on

Burgess/Teague called a "match" per CODIS:
Right; data consistent between specimens
