Youthtrack is Authorized  
To Transport Detained Youth  
In Certain Circumstances**

Youthtrack is a juvenile detention facility located within Alamosa County and serving a catchment area that includes juveniles from Alamosa County, Conejos County, Costilla County, Mineral County, Rio Grande County, and Saguache County, which are all of the counties in the 12<sup>th</sup> Judicial District.

Pursuant to various sections of Article 2, Title 19, of the Colorado Revised Statutes, Youthtrack is required to receive and provide care for any juvenile arrested or detained by court order issued by a judicial officer within the catchment area.

In order to facilitate the delivery of emergency care to juveniles in the custody of Youthtrack, the Court enters the following Order.

Now therefore, it is hereby Ordered:

Youthtrack is hereby authorized to transport any juvenile who is detained at Youthtrack and is in need of urgent or immediate medical, dental, or mental health care to the appropriate care facility. Transport may occur either by ambulance or by staff vehicle as Youthtrack in its discretion determines most appropriate.
