| POLICY REGARDING REQUESTS FOR AUDIO RECORDINGS | |

This Order formalizes the Fourteenth Judicial District's existing policy regarding requests for audio recordings of court proceedings.

Pursuant to Chief Justice Directive 05-03 V.E., each District shall create a policy outlining the procedure for requesting transcripts, tapes or digital recordings.

As technology advances, microphones are getting more sensitive and able to capture recordings that are not part of the official court record and should not be disseminated by the Court. Additionally, the Court does not have necessary technology to redact victim information from audio recordings which is a requirement of Chief Justice Directive 05-01. Therefore, copies of audio recordings will not be provided to anyone other than the persons authorized by the Court to prepare official transcripts.
