Whether you have an attorney or not, are actually involved in the process, or just want information, you are welcome to attend. Adult and minor protection professionals, law enforcement, senior care providers, and disability advocates are encouraged to attend.

The first hour of the Clinic provides Attendees with an overview of the concepts and processes involved in obtaining a Guardianship and Conservatorship. During the second hour of the Clinic, the attorneys will go through the forms for a sample case and provide some tips and answer general questions.
