<p align="center">ORDER REGARDING CORRESPONDENCE FROM THE COLORADO MENTAL HEALTH INSTITUTE AT PUEBLO (C-155)</p>	

On October 23, 2014, the Court ordered the Colorado Mental Health Institute at Pueblo (“CMHIP”) to provide the parties with all the discoverable documentation underlying the second Court-ordered sanity examination no later than October 27, 2014. Order C-154 at p. 2. In the alternative, the Court ordered CMHIP to submit a letter or pleading explaining why it is unable to provide such documentation by that date. *Id.* Yesterday, the Court received a letter from the Attorney General responding to Order C-154 on behalf of CMHIP.¹

According to CMHIP, Dr. Reid and CMHIP have already produced a considerable amount of documentation related to the second sanity examination to

the parties. Pleading C-155 at p. 2. For instance, it represents that it has provided the parties and their experts “all documentation from CMHIP,” the “raw data” from CMHIP’s psychologist, and “a lengthy production from Dr. Reid.” *Id.* However, according to CMHIP, “[g]iven the magnitude of the production to date,” it is possible that some documents responsive to Order C-154 have not yet been produced. *Id.* [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] *Id.* Based on the explanation articulated by CMHIP in its October 27 letter, the Court extends the deadline for CMHIP to provide the parties with all the discoverable documentation underlying the second Court-ordered sanity examination to November 7.
