<b>ORDER REQUIRING CMHIP TO PROVIDE THE PARTIES ALL          DISCOVERABLE DOCUMENTATION RELATED TO THE SECOND          COURT-ORDERED SANITY EXAMINATION NO LATER THAN          OCTOBER 27, 2014 (C-154)</b>	

The defendant has moved to continue the December 8, 2014 trial date. Motion D-245. One of the bases of the motion is that the parties have not yet received from the Colorado Mental Health Institute at Pueblo (“CMHIP”) the documentation underlying the second Court-ordered sanity examination. *Id.* at p. 6. In its response, the prosecution states that “CMHIP anticipates that much of the documentation will be provided on Monday, October 27, 2014,” almost two weeks after the second examiner’s report was submitted. Response at p. 1. Further, the prosecution advises that “all of the records should be provided by November 7, 2014.” *Id.* Notably, the prosecution requested the materials from CMHIP on October 6, 2014. *See* Motion D-243, Ex. A.

The Court orders CMHIP to provide the parties all the discoverable documentation related to the second Court-ordered sanity examination no later than October 27. In the alternative, CMHIP must submit a pleading or a letter no later than October 27 explaining why it needs until November 7 to make such documentation available.


