<b>ORDER REGARDING MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENA FOR LAURA NELSON (C-182)</b>	

On October 23, 2014, the defendant served a subpoena on Laura Nelson of the Colorado Department of Labor and Employment, Division of Unemployment Insurance. In Motion C-182, the Attorney General moves to quash the subpoena. Earlier today, the People and the defendant reached a stipulation that makes it unlikely that the defense will need to call Ms. Nelson as a witness at trial. *See* Ex. C-TR-3 (attached).<sup>1</sup> Accordingly, Motion C-182 is denied as moot. In the unlikely event the defense calls Ms. Nelson at trial, the Attorney General may renew its motion to quash.


