ATTORNEY ZWECK-BRONNER FROM CU DENVER APPEARS IN RESPONSE TO THE PEOPLE'S SDT (PSDT-7) AND TENDERS DOCUMENTS TO THE COURT. THE PEOPLE AND THE DEFENSE BOTH ASK THE COURT TO CONDUCT AN IN CAMERA REVIEW OF THE DOCUMENTS BEFORE DECIDING WHAT TO RELEASE TO THE PEOPLE. THE DEFENSE ALREADY HAS ALL THESE DOCUMENTS.

THE COURT GIVES THE PARTIES COPIES OF RESPONSES AND REPLIES TO PROSPECTIVE JUROR EMAILS 107, 109 AND 110, AS WELL AS PROSPECTIVE JUROR EMAIL 109A. PROSPECTIVE JUROR 1017 HAS RETURNED THIS MORNING FOR INDIVIDUAL VOIR DIRE. HE PREVIOUSLY WATCHED THE INDIVIDUAL VOIR DIRE VIDEO AND PARTICIPATED IN GROUP VOIR DIRE CONDUCTED BY THE COURT AFTER THE VIDEO. FOLLOWING INDIVIDUAL VOIR DIRE BY THE COURT AND THE PARTIES WITH PROSPECTIVE JUROR 1017, THE COURT DENIES THE DEFENSE'S CHALLENGE FOR CAUSE AND PROSPECTIVE JUROR 1017 IS ASKED TO RETURN FOR GROUP VOIR DIRE ON APRIL 13. NEXT, THE COURT CONDUCTS FURTHER INDIVIDUAL VOIR DIRE WITH PROSPECTIVE JUROR 1029, WHO WAS PREVIOUSLY QUALIFIED FOR GROUP VOIR DIRE. THE COURT RELEASES PROSPECTIVE JUROR 1029. THE COURT CONDUCTS VOIR DIRE WITH THE FOUR PROSPECTIVE JURORS WHO HAVE APPEARED THIS MORNING. THE COURT AND THE PARTIES CONDUCT INDIVIDUAL VOIR DIRE WITH THE FOUR PROSPECTIVE JURORS. BY STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES, PROSPECTIVE JURORS 1127, 1197, 1203, AND 1205 ARE RELEASED.

AFTERNOON SESSION:

DEFENDANT APPEARS IN CUSTODY WITH HIS ATTORNEYS DAN KING, KATHERINE SPENGLER, KRISTEN NELSON, AND TAMARA BRADY. THE PEOPLE ARE REPRESENTED BY KAREN PEARSON, JACOB EDSON AND LISA TEESCH MAGUIRE. THE COURT ASKS THE DEFENSE WHAT INFORMATION IT SHOULD LOOK FOR IN REVIEWING THE DOCUMENTS RESPONSIVE TO THE SDT SERVED ON CU DENVER, WHICH THE COURT ADDRESSED THIS MORNING. THE DEFENSE ASKS THE COURT TO REDACT ANY PRIVILEGED MEDICAL INFORMATION AND ANY INFORMATION THAT IS NOT RELEVANT TO THIS CASE. THE COURT ASKS THE PARTIES IF THEY HAVE REACHED A STIPULATION REGARDING PROSPECTIVE JUROR 1022, WHO WAS PREVIOUSLY QUALIFIED BUT WHO RECENTLY WROTE AN EMAIL ASKING TO BE EXCUSED. THE PEOPLE INFORM THE COURT THEY ARE NOT STIPULATING TO RELEASE PROSPECTIVE JUROR 1022. THE DEFENSE TAKES NO POSITION. THE COURT REFUSES TO RELEASE THIS PROSPECTIVE JUROR FOR THE REASONS STATED IN THE EMAILS SENT TO HIM THROUGH COURT STAFF. THE COURT CONDUCTS VOIR DIRE WITH THE GROUP OF FIVE PROSPECTIVE JURORS WHO ARE SCHEDULED THIS AFTERNOON, ALL OF WHOM APPEAR. THE COURT AND THE PARTIES CONDUCT INDIVIDUAL VOIR DIRE WITH THE FIVE PROSPECTIVE JURORS. PROSPECTIVE JURORS 1215, 1217, 1230, AND 1213 ARE EXCUSED BY STIPULATION OF THE PARTIES. WITHOUT OBJECTION, PROSPECTIVE JUROR 1238 IS ASKED TO RETURN FOR GROUP VOIR DIRE ON APRIL 13. /CMR
