THE COURT NOTIFIES THE PARTIES THAT IT WILL ISSUE A WRITTEN ORDER LATER TODAY ON THE PEOPLE'S ORAL REQUEST MADE LAST WEEK FOR AN ADDITIONAL IN CAMERA REVIEW OF DOCUMENTS PRODUCED BY THE UNIVERSITY OF COLORADO IN RESPONSE TO PSDT-1 AND PSDT-2, WHICH WERE SERVED IN 2012.  
THE DEFENSE MAKES AN ORAL MOTION IN LIMINE TO EXCLUDE TESTIMONY FROM CRIME SCENE INVESTIGATORS REGARDING IDENTIFICATION OF DECEASED VICTIMS, INCLUDING ANTICIPATED TESTIMONY FROM FINGERPRINT EXAMINER SANDRA FISHER. THE PEOPLE OBJECT TO THE MOTION. THE COURT DENIES THE MOTION AND RULES THAT THIS TESTIMONY IS RELEVANT BUT THE PEOPLE CANNOT DWELL UNNECESSARILY ON THE FINGERPRINTING OR IDENTIFICATION OF THE DECEASED VICTIMS. THE DEFENSE MAY MAKE CONTEMPORANEOUS OBJECTIONS TO SPECIFIC QUESTIONS AND THE COURT WILL RULE CONTEMPORANEOUSLY ON ANY OBJECTIONS RAISED. THE DEFENSE ALSO OBJECTS TO ANY LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' TESTIMONY DESCRIBING THE SCENE IN UPCOMING TESTIMONY DUE ITS CUMULATIVE NATURE. THE PEOPLE DISAGREE WITH THE OBJECTION.
