**CHIEF JUDGE ORDER ASSIGNING DISTRICT AND COUNTY COURT JUDGES TO SIT
INTERCHANGEABLY THROUGHOUT THE DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Article VI, Section 5, of the Colorado Constitution (C.R.S. 13-6-218) and the authority granted to Chief Judges by Chief Justice Directive 95-01, the following order is herein entered:


IT IS SO ORDERED that

- a. District court judges of the Eighteenth Judicial District are assigned to all district and county courts within the District to conduct the business of such courts as needed and required by law in all matters in all cases.
- b. Qualified county court judges, licensed attorneys who have practiced for five years or more, of the Eighteenth Judicial District, are assigned to all county and district courts within the District to conduct the business of such courts as needed and required by law, in all matters in all cases.

- c. In accordance with this order, the district administrator or designee of the Eighteenth Judicial District is authorized to assign county court judges of the District to court locations within the District having a need for assistance in hearing general docket matters or a specific case.

This order shall replace that order of January 29, 2001 and all other orders regarding the same subject and shall remain in effect until modified or rescinded by further orders of the Chief Judge of the Eighteenth Judicial District.
