### ATTENTION

### **Please do not come to court if:**

1) you have been diagnosed with COVID-19 (“Novel Coronavirus”) and you have not received a subsequent test confirming that you are currently virus-free; (2) you have been in direct contact with someone who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 within the past fourteen days; (3) you are experiencing a fever, cough, shortness of breath, recent loss of smell or taste or any other respiratory illness symptoms.

## **HOW TO FILE PLEADINGS WHILE THE COURTHOUSE ON LIMITED STAFFING**

- Pleadings will be processed according to the priority outlined by Chief Justice Coats
- Attorneys should continue to file pleadings via CCE, being cognizant of those that can wait until after July 5<sup>th</sup>. For those case types not on CCE (JV, MH, S, JA), please see below:
- Parties without an attorney may file their pleadings in WORD or PDF format ONLY to the following email address: [18JURY@judicial.state.co.us](mailto:18JURY@judicial.state.co.us)
  - This email address is for pleadings ONLY! Do not send us any questions as they will not be answered. If you have questions, please contact the court.
  - Your pleadings are not considered accepted and filed until you receive a response stating that it has been.
