

ELIGIBILITY/DISQUALIFICATION CRITERIA

The guidelines used to identify and enter offenders into the adult treatment court program.

Inclusionary

1. Voluntarily agrees to participate in the Adult Treatment Court Program
2. Resident of Weld County
3. Open CR Case
4. Meets diagnostic criteria for substance abuse or dependency pursuant to a substance evaluation
5. Probation violation, violation of deferred sentence, or a new offense where addiction appears to be a primary factor.

Exclusionary

1. Conviction or deferred sentence for current offense is not for one of the following unless the disqualification is waived by the district attorney:
 - a. Criminal enterprise drug sales
 - b. Vehicular assault or homicide or other crime involving serious bodily injury or death.
 - c. Sex offense under C.R.S. §18-1.3-1003(5)(a).
 - d. Contributing to the delinquency of a minor involving sexual factual basis
 - e. Crime involving use of a firearm.
 - f. Residential burglary when entry is into the main living space of the occupant and defendant is not a member of the family of the occupant.
 - g. 1st or 2nd degree arson
 - h. Domestic Violence
2. Pending felony charges may cause suspension or termination in the discretion of the Court. Each case will be considered on its own merits
3. Not subject to a C.R.S. §27-10 mental health hold.
4. Not subject to an Immigration and Customs Enforcement Hold
5. Not an active gang member
