ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2008-002

Approving the use of GPS, EHM, SCRAM, SOBRIETOR and OTHER
ELECTRONIC MONITORING DEVICES by Probation Officers and Private
Probation Officers (RMOMS) of the 22nd Judicial District as Intermediate
Sanctions in lieu of Revocation of Probation or Deferred Judgments.

Whereas C.R.S. 18-1.3-204(2(a)) (XIV 5) states that "When granting probation,
the court may, as a condition of probation, require that the defendant be subject
to electronic or global position monitoring.

Whereas, the use of intermediate sanctions permits more effective supervision
by the probation department and:

the use of intermediate sanctions holds the probationer more immediately
accountable for violations and:

the use of intermediate sanctions avoids congestion the court docket with
advisements of motions to revoke probation and revocation hearings,
saving time for the courts, probation and defendants.

Therefore, the undersigned Chief Judge of the 22nd Judicial District hereby
approves the use of GPS, EHM, SCRAM, SOBRIETOR and any other Electronic
Monitoring Device approved by the Colorado State Probation Department, as
intermediate sanctions to be used by probation officers and private probation
officers in lieu of revocations of probation or deferred judgments.

This condition will be checked as applicable on the terms and conditions
order for Probation as "May be subject to electronic monitoring or GPS at the
direction of the Probation Officer. It is always the discretion of the probation
officer to use intermediate sanctions or to file a motion to revoke probation.

Administrative Order 2007-0003.**
