
WHEREAS, Chief Justice Directive 05-01 (Amended April 1, 2016) (hereinafter "CJD 05-01") sets forth the Judicial Department's policy governing public access to court records and other information.

WHEREAS, CJD 05-01 allows for requests for Complied Data and Aggregate Data that is specific to the Twenty-Second Judicial District to be submitted to, prepared by, and released from the Twenty-Second Judicial District.

WHEREAS, CJD 05-01 section 4.40 provides that if data is requested from and released by a judicial district, then that judicial district is deemed to be acting as a designated agent of the State Court Administrator's Office in regard to that data request, and in that instance, the data request must be approved by the Chief Judge or Administrative Authority of that judicial district, or his/her designee, prior to the release of any data.

Therefore, the undersigned Chief Judge hereby appoints **Amelia Harris**, Clerk of Court for Montezuma County Court, and **Felicia Canzona**, Clerk of Court for Montezuma District Court, as the undersigned Chief Judge's designees for purposes of CJD 05-01 section 4.40.
