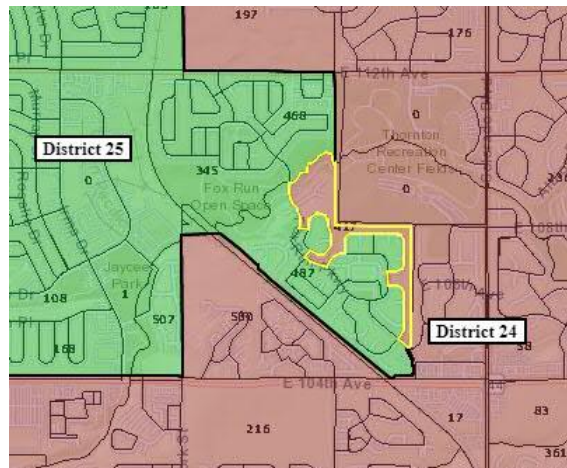

**ERRATA REGARDING EXHIBITS TO
FINAL LEGISLATIVE REDISTRICTING PLANS**

The Colorado Independent Legislative Redistricting Commission (the “Commission”) hereby provides notice of errata and submits corrected pages for its Exhibit Nos. 1, 7, and 11 submitted with the Final Legislative Redistricting Plans on October 15, 2021.

In preparing the electronic Colorado Senate map for submission to the Court, a portion of a neighborhood block within the City of Northglenn in Senate District 25 was erroneously joined with the neighboring City of Thornton in Senate District 24, as shown highlighted in yellow below:



This was an electronic scrivener’s error in preparing Exhibit 1 for submission to the Court, as the Commission’s final approved plan included the highlighted block in Senate District 25. The Commission has attached a corrected page 5 to its Exhibit 1, Final Statewide District Maps and Regional District Maps - Colorado Senate Districts

North Denver Metro Area, to correct this error. The corrected interactive map is available at: <https://bit.ly/3aSuM8Y>.

In addition, because a population of 417 persons is included within the highlighted block, the population numbers for Senate Districts 24 and 25 reported in Exhibits 7 and 11 have been corrected to show the population of the highlighted block in District 25 rather than District 24. Corrected pages for Exhibit 7, Population Charts for House and Senate (pages 2-3), and Exhibit 11, Reports Regarding Splits Analysis (page 17), are attached.
